Water emergency possible

Severe water shortages could hit the Tshwane metro because of water restrictions being ignored.

The metro said it had learnt that some residents and businesses did not adhere to the restrictions.

Tshwane metro spokesperson Lindela Mashigo urged residents to continue their responsible water usage.

"Irresponsible use of water may lead to an emergency situation of a shortage of water," Mashigo told *Rekord*.

With temperatures again soaring close to 40 degrees Celsius this week with only the occasional thunderstorm bringing some relief, the drought continued to plague Pretoria.

Management at several housing complexes in the city had closed communal swimming pools – much to the chagrin of some residents.

The water restrictions currently in place prohibited the filling of swimming pools.

"We appreciate the cooperation of its customers who heeded the call to use water sparingly.

"Unfortunately, it has come to the city's attention that there are some customers who are not complying," Mashigo said.

No new directions about water use had been issued by Rand Water, which supplied the bulk of Tshwane's water.

"The metro, however, continues to hold

water conservation awareness campaigns as part of the implementation of key interventions to reduce water demand in the metro," he said.

"The purpose of this campaign is to caution the residents that the water situation remains dire and this will hopefully bring the water demand down."

Mashigo said the metro received 72% of its drinking water from Rand Water. Thus a notice to impose further water restrictions would come from Rand Water.

One percent of the metro's water came from Magalies Water with the rest of the water supply coming from the metro's own water sources such as fountains, boreholes and from the Roodeplaat Water Treatment Plant.

"Should there be a need to impose stricter restrictions, Rand Water will issue Tshwane with a notice," said Mashigo.

The metro issued some water saving tips such as installing a low-flow shower head and tap aerators, planting indigenous or drought-resistant shrubs in the garden and to water gardens between 18:00 and 06:00 only when really necessary.

The metro advised that rain water should be collected for re-use in the garden or for washing a vehicle.

Covering a swimming pool would reduce evaporation. Shower rather than bath and close the running tap while brushing teeth or shaving.

Pretoria experienced another heat wave

this week with the mercury reaching 39 degrees on Monday. Temperatures started going down slightly on Tuesday.

The Tshwane SPCA advised owners not take their dogs for walks during the heat of the day.

"One did not always realise how hot the

tar roads get and should dogs be taken for a walk, it should preferably be done early in the mornings or late in the afternoon," Tshwane SPCA manager Korky Levanon said.

She urged pet owners to keep water bowls in shaded spots or to even freeze bowls.

Inwoners in die noorde en Moot het ingespring om slagoffers by te staan en danks skenkings kon gesinne van hul verlore besittings vervang.

Van die huisgesinne is steeds afhanklik van ander vir blyplek, nadat die skade hul sakke geruk het.

'n Gesin in Mayville is een van die wat steeds in 'n woonstel bly nadat hul huis in

November afgebrand het.

Phillip du Plessis het vroeër aan *Rekord* vertel hoe die rusbank in hul leefkamer vlamgevat het en die vuur vinnig deur die res van die huis versprei het.

"Ons vermoed dit was 'n kortsluiting omdat die kragkabel naby die bank gelê het," vertel Du Plessis.

Hy sê 'n assessor sal binnekort wel kan vasstel wat die oorsaak was.

Hy, sy vrou en hul vier kinders bly op die oomblik in 'n tuinwoning.

'n Goedhartige buurvrou het haarself oor die gesin ontferm en hulle die verblyf aangebied.

Ander gesinne wat deurgeloopt het moet soos Du Plessis en sy gesin die skerwe optel en van voor af begin.

Solidariteit en inwoners veg saam teen mense-roof

Suid-Afrika tel onder die top 10 lande waar mensehandel bedryf word.

Solidariteit Helpende Hand het dié feit aan die lig gebring en die erns van die misdryf met besorgde ouers en inwoners van Pretoria bespreek.

Solidariteit Helpende Hand se Andeon-tak het besluit om mensehandel met 'n dapper nuwe projek aan te pak.

Die Beskerm-jou-kind-projek se eerste funksie het die afgelope naweek by Laerskool Tygerpoort in Pretoria plaasgevind.

Die bekende akteur Hykie Berg en Elanie Kruger, skrywer van die boek *Skooldag tot Bordeelbed*, was die gassprekers.

Berg en Kruger is albei betrokke by PSARU (People Search and Rescue Unit) en kon uit eerstehande ervaring praat oor mensehandel in Suid-Afrika.

Volgens PSARU verdwyn daar elke ses ure 'n kind in Suid-Afrika. Die organisasie help om vermiste persone op te spoor.

"Mense wat 'n dwelmprobleem het en 'n slagoffer van mensehandel is, lyk net soos ek en jy. Dit kan met enigeen gebeur," het Berg verduidelik.

"Negentig persent van die slagoffers is wit vroue en kinders."

Byna 100 besorgde ouers het opgedaag om te hoor hoe om hul kinders teen die gevaar van mensehandel te beskerm.

"Daar is ook 'n studiefonds gestig om

slagoffers van mensehandel en gerehabiliteerde dwelmverslaafdes wat wil gaan studeer, te ondersteun," het Marlien van der Westhuizen, van Solidariteit Helpende Hand in 'n nuusverklaring gesê.

Kruger was self vir agt maande as 'n sekskslaaf gevange gehou is nadat 'n familie-vriend haar aan 'n bordeel verkoop het.

Sy het ouers aangemoedig om 'n goeie verhouding met hul kinders te hê om so seker te maak dat hulle weet waarmee hul kinders besig is.

"Jy moet jou kinders se maats ken; jy moet weet waarheen hulle gaan. Ons leef nie meer in 'n wêreld waar jy jou kind gou kafee toe kan stuur nie," sê Kruger.

Helpende Hand se Andeon-tak het besluit om die funksie te hou na 'n reeks mislukte kinderontvoerings in die stad.

Al die wins wat met die funksie gemaak is, is aan die studiefonds geskenk," sê Van der Westhuizen.

"Die fonds het reeds R64 000 ingesamel, waarvan Solidariteit-hoofkantoor R25 000 geskenk het as deel van hul Rand-vir-Rand-projek."

Tshwane metro has introduced 1 925 new police officers to their ranks.

The graduation of new recruits was recently celebrated at the Lucas Moripe Stadium in Atteridgeville.

Family and friends of graduates attended the event where new officers made an oath to be honest and work hard.

Tshwane mayor Kgosi Ramokgopa congratulated the graduates and advised them not to compromise the two years of dedication and commitment of their training by taking bribes.

"Do not get greedy because we pay you salaries," he added.

The MMC for Community Safety, Cllr Terence Mashogo, congratulated the recruits and encouraged them to wear their uniform with pride, walk tall and bring pride and dig-

nity to their uniforms by not taking bribes.

The trainees were now full-fledged metro police constables who were encouraged to work their way up.

"The constables have stood the test of time. They have demonstrated their mental and physical ability and their tenacity and commitment," the metro said in a statement.

"They have also shown resilience and an impeccable work ethic by undergoing such a competitive, gruelling regimen of training and studying."

Ramokgopa has since promised that the metro police would deploy ten officers per ward. This is part of a strategy to make the city a safer place for residents.

The event included a parade by the metro police, gymnastics, a physical training display, aerobics, firearm and drill displays.

The metro police band and choir also performed for guests.

Frans Roos, pa van 'n 23-maande-oue dogtertjie, sê hy het onlangs 'n klage by die Villieria-polisie gelê dat sy kind in die gesig geslaan is.

"Die merke sit duidelik aan haar wang," het Roos ontstig gesê.

Roos se vrou Elmarie vertel sy was gesig toe sy die rooi merke op haar kind se gesig sien nadat sy haar by die dagsorgsentrum gaan haal het.

"Daar was wit goed aan my kind se gesig waarmee ek dink die mense by die skool die merke probeer toesmeer het," sê sy.

Edeth Olckers, eenaar van Lion King-dagsorgsentrum, ontken dat sy of een van die versorgers by die sentrum die kind geslaan het.

"Ek het reeds vir die ouers gesê dat hul dogtertjie 'n ander seuntjie geby het, waarna hy haar in die gesig gekrap het," sê Olckers.

"Ek het self haar wang skoongemaak en self aangesmeer om te keer dat sy nie infeksie kry nie."

Elmarie vertel by wyse van foto's dat haar dogtertjie bloed onder haar lippe het

en sê sy het dit opgemerk na die beweerde aanval.

Olckers hou vol dat sy nooit enige van die kinders by die skool sal seermaak nie, en sê die 23-maande-oue dogtertjie het nog dieselfde dag aartappelskyfies en ander kos geniet.

"As sy enigins binne haar mond seer gehad het, sou ek daarvan geweet het."

Olckers sê sy is geskok oor die aantygings en die ouers se optrede.

Ander ouers by die sentrum staan bankwas agter Olckers, of soos hulle liefdevol na haar verwys as 'Ouma Edeth'.

Verlede jaar het van die ouers haar verdedig toe daar 'n bewering was dat daar 'n klapperk op 'n kind se boud was.

"My seuntjie is nou in graad R en hy was vir drie jaar by Ouma Edeth. My babadogtertjie is sedert Januarie by haar.

"Ek sal nie vir een oomblik glo dat Ouma Edeth die mens is wat daardie ouers haar uitmaak om te wees nie," het een van die ouers verlede jaar aan *Rekord* gesê.

Nog ouers het Olckers verdedig.

Roos sê sy kind is nou by 'n ander dagsorgsentrum.

Olckers sê sy dra nie kennis van die klage wat by die polisie gelê is nie.

Sy noem ook dat ouers wat verlede jaar soortlike bewerings gemaak het nou weer goeie vriende met haar is.

Fibre-optic network rolled out in 2016

A fibre-optic network comprising approximately 2 000km of cable is set to be rolled out in the Tshwane metro next year.

The installation will continue for five years.

Craig Carthy, director of LinkAfrica, said this would help speed up home internet access.

"The Tshwane metro communication backlog will be solved by the state of the art fibre-optic network. It will take some time until every resident has a modern telecommunications service."

After a long legal battle to roll out the fibre-optic network, the courts have pronounced on the rights of the parties involved.

Following the judgment, telecommunications firms such as LinkAfrica will now be able to roll out the network on public and private property.

"We will give due regard to applicable legislation, such as common law of servitudes, bylaws, health and safety laws,"

said Carthy.

He said telecommunications firms were expected to approach property owners to inform them about the laying of fibre-optic cables on their property.

"Any installation entails a lot of mess, as these cables are traditionally buried underground."

"We will deploy the fibre-optic network with our patented technology, Focus [fibre-optical cable in underground systems], which is used by all South African telecommunications firms, such as voice and internet service providers, to place cables in existing sewers and storm water pipes," he said.

Carthy said the new network deployment will be faster and cheaper.

"It will [also] cause less destruction of roads and pavements. Once installed, the tenants and property owners can enjoy being connected to the digital age," he said.

The new fibre-optic network will complement the Tshwane metro's rollout of free Wi-Fi hotspots.

Boy electrocuted in Eersterust

The Eersterust Police has opened an inquiry into the death of a three-year-old boy whose body was found at a scrapyard.

The boy had apparently been electrocuted.

Spokesperson Sergeant Sam Shibambo said police arrived at the site on Monday, around 16:30, and found the child dead.

"Apparently the child and other families are staying in Wendy houses at

the scrapyard. This is not allowed and very dangerous as the electric wiring [to supply the houses with power] is not done properly," says Shibambo.

Police suspect the boy came in contact with an exposed live wire.

Henry Godfrey, chairperson of the Eersterust CPF, informed *Rekord* earlier about the incident, also confirming that the child was electrocuted long before a lightning storm lit up the evening sky.

The boy and his family have not been identified.

Investigations continue.

Church Square origins

Ever wondered what the capital city looked like in the 1800s?

Images have emerged of what Church Square and parts of Pretoria looked like before massive developments and the current A Re Yeng construction.

Friedel Hansen shared the images on social media.

The photos portray Pretoria's historical lifestyle at a time when there was limited traffic and residents got around on either bicycles or horse-drawn carriages.

Hansen shared many images of the 1800s Church Square where the first church was built but burnt down in 1882 after being struck by lightning.

Tussen die Magaliesberg en Daspooort, vanaf Derdepoort in die ooste tot by Maanhaarrand in die weste, lê die vallei wat almal as die Moot ken.

Die Moot met sy talle woongebiede vorm deel van Pretoria en is miskien nog die mees gemeenskap-georiënteerde gebied in die stad. Hoewel inwoners in die Moot 'n verskeidenheid kulture verteenwoordig, bly Afrikaans hul dominante taal en behou hulle sterk gesinswaardes.

By die ontstaan van Pretoria in 1855, was die Moot in plase opgedeel. Van die eerste plaaseienaars was die Bronkhorsts, die Foursies en die Erasmusse.

Die vyf hoofplase is in Rietfontein, Derdepoort, Koedoespoort, Elandsport en Wonderpoort opgerig. Die Moot was oorspronklik 'n wateryke gebied en uiters geskik vir boerdery. Die Apiesrivier wat

noordwaarts deur Wonderboompoort vloei, was destyds 'n belangrike waterbron.

Daar was (en is steeds) spruite op talle plekke. Tussen 7e en 8e Laan in Wonderboom-Suid begin die Mootspruit wat in die Apiesrivier eindig.

Die Moot-Noord-spruit het tussen 32e en 33e Laan ontstaan en die Moot-Suidspruit begin by die park in Mōregloed en vloei deur Villieria en Rietfontein.

Die ou Pretoria was 'n landelike dorpie omring deur plase. Tyd het dit verander en die dorpie het 'n stad geword met groter strukture en digter woongebiede.

Die Moot het saam verander en plase is omskep in kleiner woneiendomme. Vandag is die Moot 'n kommersiële gebied met talle sake-ondernemings en woonstelblokke.

Hoewel die gebied saam met die stad gegroei het, behou die Moot die gevoel van 'n hegte gemeenskap. Vra

maar enige inwoner en raadslid waarom hulle gebied so uitnemend is. Die antwoord: Moot-inwoners staan saam.

We drive down Botha Avenue after school. Water ran down the street. We almost swam. Does someone see to the mending of the broken water pipe?

Phoning the local authorities to report the problem doesn't help as the phone rings and rings. The lines are currently busy. Is everybody too busy? Meanwhile the precious water goes to waste on the streets.

Water is precious. It also grows fruit, vegetables and flowers in greenhouses, and helps to fill barrels for livestock.

The question remains: who is responsible for protecting this country's water resources and if it runs dry, will there be someone left to take the blame?

I can only hope that everyone will take up the responsibility and stand together to protect the precious water supply.

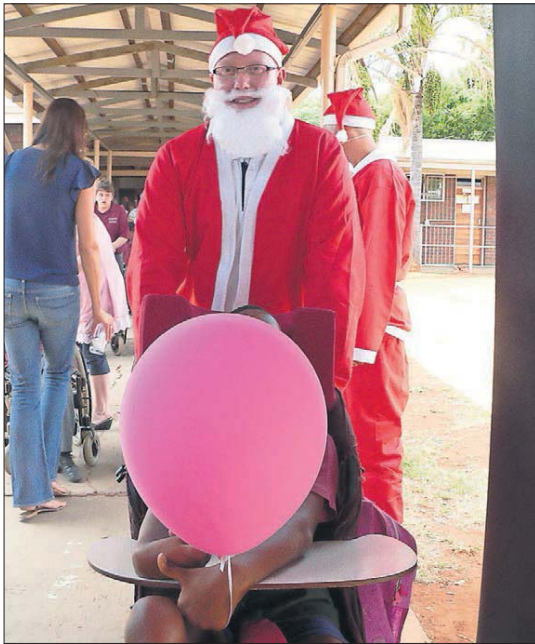

Special treat for very special kids

Pretoria School for cerebral palsied, physically and learning disabled pupils celebrated Christmas early this year.

All the little faces lit up as a hundred colourful balloons were released into the sky recently.

The day kicked off with the pupils performing and singing Christmas carols on stage.

Each of the children received a special treat and present while enjoying a fun-filled day in the sun.

The school is a government-subsidised non-profit organisation which accommodates children between the ages of three and 18.

Cerebral palsy is a condition among children with various degrees of brain damage. It is usually the result of an injury to the immature central nervous system.

Depending on the extent of and the area damaged, different disabilities such as epilepsy, physical and/or learning problems, hearing, visual and

speech impairment may occur.

Because early intervention is important, the school also provides services such as baby evaluations and weekly therapy sessions.

The staff consists of 31 teachers, six occupational therapists, five speech therapists, five physiotherapists, three psychologists, three nursing staff, five administrative clerks and 17 class and/or general assistants.

The school has a junior and a senior hostel that accommodates a total of 96 children.

These children have the same dreams as other children, although it takes much more courage and perseverance to reach their goals.

Specialised education is very costly because remedial equipment is needed to enable children to reach their potential.

However, the state subsidy is insufficient. Therefore the school is mostly dependent on contributions from donors.

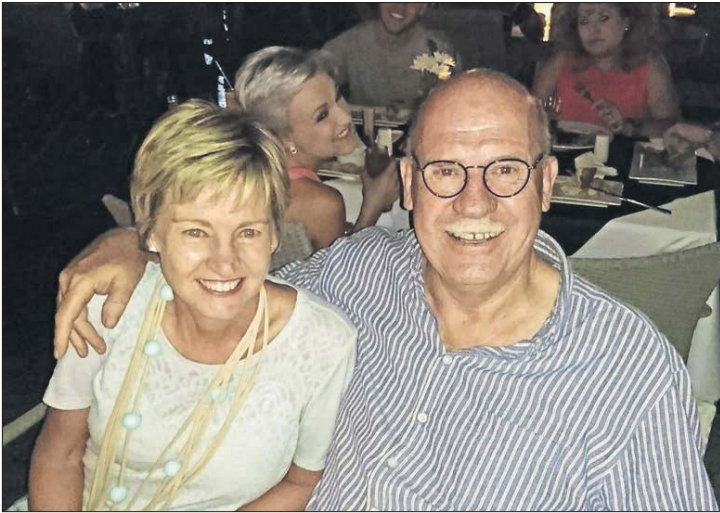

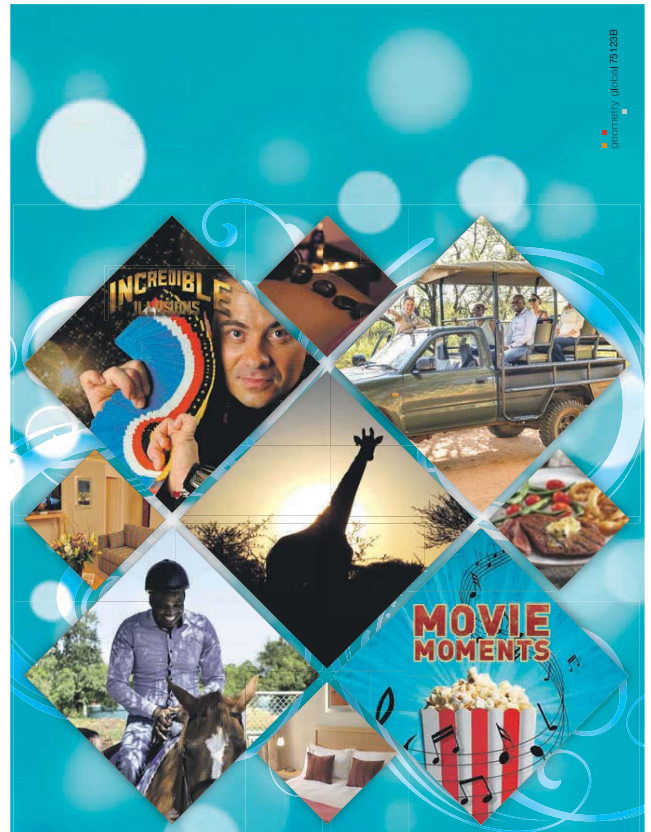

Should you buy your childhood home?

There are all sorts of reasons why you might want to buy the property you grew up in, but you should not let your head rule your heart.

That is the advice of Richard Gray, CEO of Harcourts Real Estate, who says as the trend towards multigenerational living gains ground, young adults are now not only moving back in with their parents but increasingly, buying their parents' homes with the intention of also raising their own families there.

"According to Professor John Graham, a co-author of *All in the Family: A Practical Guide to Successful Multigenerational Living*, this is consistent with the steady return to the interdependence of the extended family and the move away from the nuclear family model," he says.

"In our experience it is also consistent with the rising age of first-time buyers, who are now often in their mid-30s and watching their parents get close to retirement," he says.

However, you should not buy your parents' home for any sentimental reason.

You need to think about it carefully, decide if it is really the home you want, and seek professional advice from an experienced estate agent, a reputable mortgage originator and your accountant or tax attorney before you sign an offer to purchase.

"For example, you need to consider the

location, just as you would when looking at any other property," he says.

Is it close enough to work and does it offer reliable public transport?

Does it have all the shops, schools and other amenities you need?

Is it safe, or would it perhaps be better if you all moved to another home in a more secure area or development?"

In addition, you need to evaluate the condition of the property itself.

"If your parents are getting on, there may well be some deferred maintenance and to avoid the possibility of family disputes later, you will need to identify these and reach agreement about who will do the work and who will pay for repairs that may be needed before you buy," he says.

"As with any other property, you will need to keep the potential resale value in mind.

Updates or alterations may be needed now to make the house work for your extended family but you will need to be careful not to overcapitalise and not to limit the appeal of the property for future buyers.

"What is more, you will need to comply with local building bylaws and, if the house is in a security estate, you may also need to get the approval of the Homeowners' Association before you can make any changes."

At the same time you will have to esta-



blish whether you can afford the property and how you will finance the purchase.

"The biggest obstacle for most first-time buyers is the deposit, and your parents may be willing to help you with that, but then you must agree on how you are going to pay it back - especially if the loan came out of their retirement funds," he says.

"Similarly, you will need to agree on a fair purchase price, bearing in mind if your parents set a price that is too far below mar-

ket value in an attempt to help you qualify for a loan, the SA Revenue Service could view the transaction as an attempt to avoid paying transfer duty. You will also need to qualify for a home loan in the usual way, as the banks cannot make any allowances for the fact that it is your parents' home you are buying. In other words, you will need a good credit record, steady employment and enough discretionary income to afford the monthly bond repayments."

Older property sales still have buying power

Interesting buying trends have emerged over the last three months, showing that the number of first-time buyer home loan applications seem to be tapering off, while older buyers are spending more, says Adrian Goslett, regional director and CEO of RE/MAX of Southern Africa.

Goslett notes that according to BetterLife Home Loans statistics for the RE/MAX group for the period June-August, there has been a decline in home loan applications from first time buyers, while the average deposit requirement for first-time buyers has increased from just over 10% in June to 13.68% in August.

The average loan-to-value offered to

first time buyers has also dropped from 91% in June to 88% in August.

Analysis of all home loan applications received by BetterLife Home Loans reflects that overall loan-to-value ratios have decreased from around 86% to just above 84%, while average deposit requirements have increased from 19% to just over 21%.

"Despite a slight increase in average salaries of the applicants, the cost of living has increased dramatically and many consumers are finding their budgets stretched.

"That is why saving up for a property, or having a 'rainy-day fund' savings account when you own a property is important," says Goslett.

"In light of interest rate hikes and a constrained economy, it is not surprising that the loan-to-value average has decreased slightly, or that the deposit requirements have increased."

Looking at buying trends, Goslett points out the majority of home loans granted through BetterLife Home Loans for RE/MAX applicants has been for homes within the R500 000 to R1 million price range (41%), while 21% were for properties priced between R1 million and R1.5 million.

Those properties priced between R1.5 million and R2.5 million accounted for just 16% of home loans granted to RE/MAX buyers.

Provincially, properties within Western Cape had the highest average purchase price among all the provinces for the period June to August at R1.576 million.

Interestingly, it was Mpumalanga that followed at R1.345 million, then the Free State at R1.277 million, while the average purchase price for property in KwaZulu-Natal during the June-August period was R1.164 million.

Surprisingly, Gauteng lagged behind with an average purchase price of R1.16 million.

While the average age of buyers applying for home loans remains at the 37 year old mark, the more mature generations continue to have greater buying power.

Yes, I fractured a finger. I had surgery on the finger, and am at 95% at this stage. It was a tough six weeks, but the support I received was incredible.

It was better to have the surgery at the start of the season, so now I am much better and fit for the final.

The tournament has become one of the biggest T20s in the world. It is shown all over the world, and we have more and more international players in it. It would be great if it could become as big as the Indian Premier League (IPL).

SA flush with young netball talent, says coach

South Africa is flush with talented young netball players who have shown exceptional technical ability at national trials last week.

They certainly have what it takes to compete at international level, says u.21 national team coach Dorette Badenhorst.

She was speaking on the final day of a four-day long training camp for select young players.

Badenhorst, who also coaches the North West Flames in the Brutal Fruit Netball Premier League, said she was highly impressed by the talent on show.

Players were put through conditioning exercises, training drills and competitive matches.

South Africa moved up to fifth place on the International Netball Federation (INF) World Rankings in 2015, and Netball South Africa is keen to continue the improvement across all its national teams.

Talent identification and development has therefore been prioritised by the federation.

Some 80 girls between the ages of 16 and 19 were invited to the Pretoria camp after being identified at various tournaments across the country and 66 attended the training from Tuesday to Friday.

The camp was overseen by Badenhorst, who was assisted by SPAR Proteas Maryka Holtzhausen, Phumza Maweni, Erin Burger, and Lenise Potgieter as well as Brutal Fruit NPL goal shooter Dumisani Chauke.

"In just four days we have watched how the players have come into their own in terms of understanding what is expected of them to make it to the national setup," said Badenhorst.

"The players applied what they were taught and really impressed all of us with not only their performance on the court but also their attitude and desire."

Another important element that Badenhorst noticed was the flexibility displayed by the players.

"Yesterday I moved one player from goal keeper to centre and she did really well in mid court. I've never seen such energy before and she surprised us," Badenhorst said.

"Usually in training camps, players flock to play in the middle of the court.

"However, this training camp had an unexpected and surprising outcome where the majority of the girls preferred to be in the defensive line."

Despite her optimism, Badenhorst em-

phasised that the girls still had a long way to go because of their varying netball backgrounds and the high standard of international netball.

For 19-year-old Sigi Burger, one of the best newcomers at the Brutal Fruit NPL this year, the training camp is her opportunity to grow.

Shange aims for a 2016 medal

Breaking South African race walking records will be the last thing on Lebogang Shange's mind next year.

The goal he will be striving for will be much more difficult and also much more important.

He will be preparing himself to get a top-three finish in the 20km race walk at the Olympic Games in Rio. To prove how serious he is about this, he has stuck a big note on the ceiling of his bedroom. It is the last thing he sees before he turns off the light at night and it reminds him why he has to push his body to the limit day after day and why he needs to make certain sacrifices.

Shange was the most prolific record breaker this season. He did so on no less than five occasions but now he cannot help wondering whether it was worth the effort.

"People read about my record-breaking exploits and see me talk about it on television and they presume that I must be raking in 'big' money. The honest truth is I did not get one cent for any of the records I have broken. I actually received very little recognition for my efforts from any of the decision makers in South African sports. All I received was one congratulatory letter from a personal assistant working at Athletics

South Africa (ASA) and that was it.

"That is why I am planning to change my whole strategy next year. I am going to be more selective when and where I will race. I am not getting any younger and therefore it is important that I start to make a living as a race walker."

Shange is planning to do things differently next year. His coach, Chris Britz, wants him to drastically change his racing strategy. "Chris wants me to start racing from the front, rather than chasing down the leaders over the last kilometres. I guess adapting to a new racing strategy will take some time.

"One of the things I love about race walking is the chase over the last kilometres. While I am racing I get involved to such an extent that I totally forget about the kilometres. All that matters is catching up and passing the athletes in front of me. But I am up to the new challenge. Chris reckons it will take about three races for me to get used to racing from the front.

"Although my focus will not be on breaking any records, my aim will still be to consistently walk times of between 1:18:00 and 1:22:00. If I manage to do that, I ought to be able to get a top-five or better finish in Rio.

"Racing at the Olympic Games is usually

a tactical battle."

Shange is full of praise for the role Monja Human, a sports psychologist at Tuks/hpc, plays in his success as a race walker.

"I must admit that I, especially coming from a township, was sceptical at first about

going to see a psychologist.

"I thought it was only crazy people who did so, but she totally changed my perception about psychology. Monja helped me believe in my abilities as a race walker and to be fearless when I race."

Successful year for SA triathlon champ

It is easy to set goals, but to achieve them can be a huge challenge.

This is why the 20-year-old Basson Engelbrecht (Tuks/hpc) has good reason to feel proud about what he has achieved this season as a triathlete.

"I set myself five goals and I have achieved four of them. If it had not been for the fact that I was bitten by a spider, it could have been five out of five. But I am not complaining. I have had my best year ever as a triathlete."

Engelbrecht won the South African triathlon title. Although Richard Murray (bronze medallist at the World Championships), Henri Schoeman and Wian Sullwald were all absent, Engelbrecht was the best of the competitors on the day and the title is his.

He also finished third at the African Championships, won an African

Cup event in Mauritius and participated in three World Series races.

The only goal he failed to accomplish was achieving a top-five finish in the u.23 race at the World Championships in Chicago, but that was not due to any fault of his. He was bitten by a spider while he was on a training run in Hungary. As luck would have it, the wound became septic after a few days and he was unable to train for quite a few weeks.

This forced him to withdraw from the World Championships.

"The most important lesson I have learned this year was not to take anything for granted. I had a dream start to my season but it took one spider to get my season spiralling downwards at an alarming speed. I now realise how fragile the human body can be and why it is so important for a professional athlete to look after himself.

"Being an hpc athlete is a great help because it gives me immediate access to experts whenever I experience a crisis."

Engelbrecht fully realises that his best chance to represent South Africa at an Olympic Games will be in Tokyo in 2020, but this is not going to stop him from doing everything in his power in an effort to slip through the proverbial "backdoor" for the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio.

"I am planning to race as often as I can during the early part of the season in an effort to improve my international ranking sufficiently to perhaps qualify. But I fully realise it will be a challenge against all odds.

"A more realistic goal would be to podium in the u.23 race at the World Championships. I will also target one World Cup race for a possible victory," Engelbrecht concluded.
