School bids farewell to principal

Greenbury Primary School bids farewell in style to their beloved principal, Suresh Deenanath, after 36 years of service, by hosting a farewell party to give this much-loved former teacher the send off he deserves. Dignitaries from the Department of Education (DOE) and the South African Teachers Association (SADTU) establishment, along with ex-colleagues from his illustrious career came to pay homage to the legacy left by his departure.

Deenanath described himself as a Verulam boy who grew up under very humbling circumstances. He described his youth in an emotional speech at the ceremony, as a childhood spent living in poverty with a loving and supportive family. "I know first hand what it means to be poor. I don't believe that there was any other family as poor as ours. It is only through the sacrifice and support of my brother, who was forced to leave school and work to support us, that I was able to become the educated man that you see now. That is why, from the moment I became a teacher, I swore an oath to always ensure that every child under our care is given the best education," explained the emotional former principal.

Deenanath stayed true to his oath and applied an attitude of excellence in every aspect of his career as a teacher and as a principal. He first qualified as a teacher in 1975, and always had a strong sense of the injustices of apartheid that existed in the country at that time. He taught at some of the roughest and toughest areas in Johannesburg and became one of the members of

the revolutionary movement taking place in South Africa. He joined the Department of Education in 1980 and taught at various schools including Grandmore Primary and Cottonlands Primary in Verulam. According to his colleagues, what set Deenanath apart from many other dedicated teachers was his incredible organisational and managerial acumen.

The newly appointed chief education specialist at the Department of Education, Mr SSS Lushozi, took time out of his busy schedule to attend the ceremony and offered a touching speech about the way in which Deenanath influenced his career. He said, "During the early stages of my career as a principal, I asked to meet the best in the field in my region and I was referred to Suresh. I have learnt so much from this man about the 'management' of a school. He is a luminary of education, an entrepreneur, manager, organiser and networker of impeccable standards." Deenanath was also an active member of SADTU for many years and was credited with being the driving force behind lifting the organisation out of debt after he was appointed the provincial treasurer in 1980. The chief of staff at the premier office, Mr M Mathonsi, explained in detail the pivotal role that Deenanath made to the movement of the organisation through sheer intelligence and financial savvy. He said, "Our organisation was under heavy debt when we managed to get Suresh on board. In his time with us, he successfully rebranded the organisation and showed us that we are a real force that can

bring about change. He helped us become the well functioning entity we are today." One of the school's sponsors, Mr Ruben Govender described how the Greenbury principal changed Phoenix by organising what is believed to be the very first feeding schemes of

its kind, which is now done in many poverty-stricken institutions across the province. His staff and the teachers paid homage to his leadership abilities, while a farewell video from the school children was played for the crowd. The esteemed guests were also treated to a dance routine from some of the pupils. DOE circuit manager, Dr LP Swartz, also spoke of the former principal's leadership as an example of exemplary work in education. He also made reference to a lesser known quote from Nelson Mandela, 'The success of this country will not be determined by extraordinary people doing ordinary things, but by ordinary people doing extraordinary things.' There is little doubt in the minds of all those who attended, that Madiba had a man like Suresh Deenanath in mind when he penned that phrase.

Deenanath now plans to spend more time reconnecting with his friends and loved ones but leaves the door open to anyone who may need his assistance in the future.

Man's skull crushed in Brooksfarm

Residents of Brooksfarm have been left baffled and afraid after a local resident's skull was smashed open on Saturday morning in what is believed to be a motiveless attack. The victim has been identified as Peter Nzala, who lives in the area.

According to police, the victim left his residence at 6:30am to make his way to a local tuck shop in the area to buy something. The tuck shop owner recognised the voice of the man and called out to tell him to wait while he went to change his clothes and be more presentable. It was during this time that the victim was attacked. Phoenix SAPS communications officer, Lt Louise Naidoo said, "The witness heard a commotion outside and was not sure what was happening so he waited a few minutes before

looking out and saw four men flee from the scene. The witness then went to see what was happening and noted that the window of the bakkie had been smashed, before looking down and noticing the gruesome sight of the murdered victim." Based on the state of the victim, it is alleged that the surrounding debris may have been used to smash the victim's head to such an extent that his skull collapsed leaving the brain matter exposed. It is unknown if the victim was actually robbed as it was not known if he was carrying anything at that hour of the morning. Police are unclear on any motives that may have led to the killing of the victim and is encouraging members of the community who may have information to call 10111.

Increase of killings at KwaMashu hostels

Violence across the hostels in KwaMashu has taken a turn for the worse after one man was killed and another seriously injured in another unexplained shooting, less than 24 hours after the execution-style killing of four men, on Sunday evening.

The first incident took place on Monday at the hostel. A 46-year-old man was killed by unknown man in a men's hostel. Provincial SAPS spokesman, Lieutenant Nqobile Gwala said, "Two men were shot in a men's hostel by unknown men. One was pronounced dead at the scene while the other victim was injured and taken to hospital. There is no known motive for the killing and a case of murder and attempted murder has been opened."

On Sunday at 6.50pm, it was reported that four men were killed, in an execution style, at a hostel located in Block 192. According to the media reports, the killings were done in an execution style. Police spokesman, Major Shooz Magudulela said, "The victims were aged

between 24 and 33 and were shot by unknown suspects. Three sustained gunshot wounds to the back and one on the face. The motive is unknown at this stage. Four counts of murder were opened at KwaMashu police station for investigation and no arrests have been made. We cannot comment further since the matter is still under investigation."

No suspects have been arrested in either instance and both cases are still under investigation.

Bogus Samaritans rob stranded motorist

High-impact collision leaves three injured

A high-impact collision between three vehicles on the N2 north between the M25 and Gateway off-ramp in Umhlanga left three people injured, on Monday night.

Paramedics arrived at the scene and found accident debris and the twisted frames of the vehicle spread over a large area. At the time of the statement being issued, it was unsure if any

people were trapped in the burning vehicle.

Medics found three other people that were injured, one critically injured and two others with moderate injuries.

The patients were treated at the scene before being transported to various hospitals for the care that they required. Their current condition remains unknown at this stage.

According to a statement issued by Netcare 911, at 9:43pm, paramedics responded to the collision.

"Reports from the scene indicated that three vehicles were involved in what appears to have been a high-impact collision. One of the vehicles veered off the road and burst into flames," the statement read.

SAPS crackdown on illegal tow truck operators

Illegal tow truck drivers have become a growing concern for the police service in Phoenix and for motorists. In recent weeks, Phoenix SAPS have reported a growing number of reports of vehicles being illegally towed away from car accident scenes without the permission of the car owner, or by threatening the driver. Station commissioner, Col Munusamy wants to send out a strong message to these illegal operators that this will not be tolerated and that more attention will not be paid to the operating practices of the tow truck industry.

He said, "Under our laws, the owner of the vehicle involved in an accident has the right to call the towing service of their choice, or of the choice of their insurer, but what we are now finding is that the cars of many motorists are being forcibly removed from the scene without the permission of the owner and taken to a panel beater of their choice. Owners are then being forced to pay these operators huge sums of money for their service or for storage costs in order to have their car released. This is unacceptable." A Phoenix mother, who does not wish to be identified, is all too familiar with this tale

after she and one of her children were involved in a car accident when an illegal tow truck driver attended the scene. She said, "My child was driving the car when the accident occurred but I am the owner of the car. While I was on my way to the scene, the tow truck driver came to assist and offered to tow the car to the side of the road which my frantic child agreed to and signed the document. Once this was signed, they towed my car away without my permission and then demanded R3,000 to get it back. I refused and went straight to the police." Col Munusamy assisted the family with the issue and the car was later retrieved after a smaller fee for storage cost was paid. According to the colonel, such experiences have become common for many motorists. "Many of these operators are being run by drug dealers and they can be dangerous. We do not want this to become common place and we urge all residents to report these incidents," he said.

Leadership through faith

Annipen describes his time on the radio show as incredibly informative and he was pleasantly surprised by the response that he received from listeners on the social media platforms. He said, "The audience was extremely responsive to the topic and I was able to converse with the listeners on the points raised on the issue. People, leaders in particular, are changing their mindset on how they approach this topic. There is a greater focus of how we as leaders, community, religious or even political, go about performing the roles that we are entrusted with."

The former school teacher is now a co-author, preacher, conference speaker, spokesman and member of the National Executive committee for his party and envisions a bright future for the community. "I would like to see it become a relatable issue for everyone. I believe that through embracing our faith, we can improve the way we serve the community and unite the people of Phoenix and surrounding areas," added Annipen.

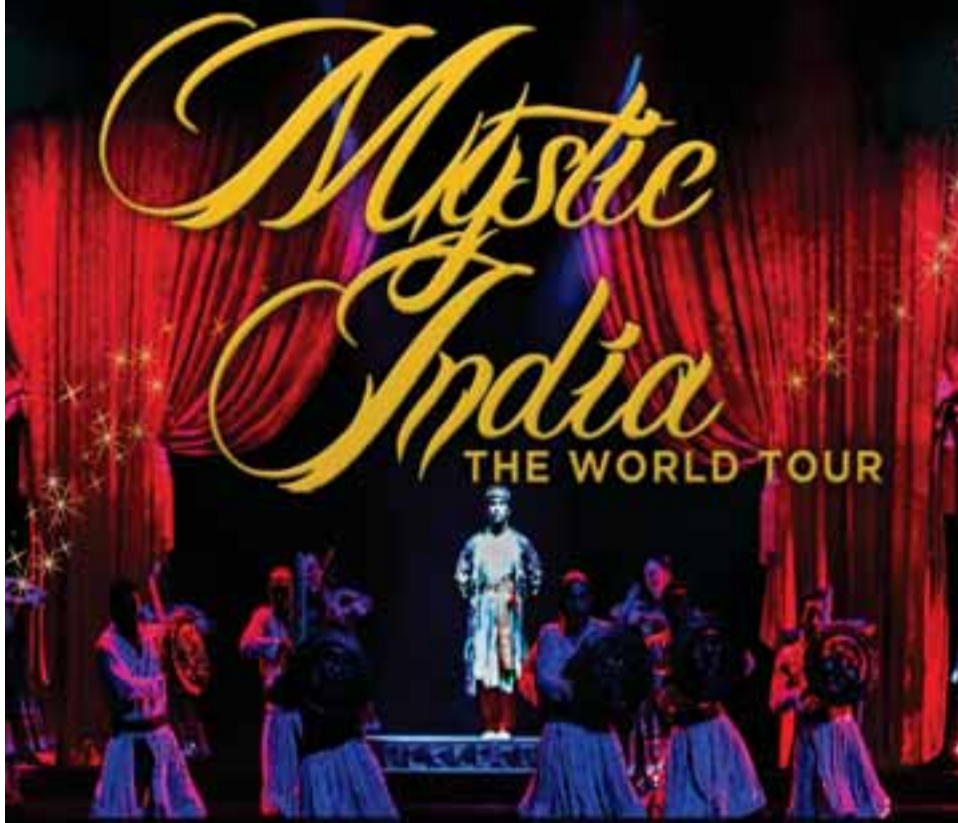

Reaction officer attacked by robbers

"The suspect removed the officers firearm and the three fled the scene leaving the officer in a pool of blood."

The life of a local security firm officer hangs in the balance after he was violently beaten and left for dead while trying to arrest men who were involved in a business robbery on Monday afternoon. The officer, Jerry John, was hit on the head with a brick and with the butt of a gun before losing consciousness. The CEO of the company, Prem Balram, relayed in detail the events leading up to the attack on his Facebook page. He said, "Upon arrival, the officers noticed a suspect fleeing the premises over a fence another officer pursued him on foot. Reaction Officer Jerry John approached the rear of the building and noticed a second suspect fleeing the building through a door. Upon noticing the officer, the suspect ran back into the building. John gave chase and upon entering the building he noticed the there were two suspects inside.

The Reaction Officer managed to arrest both suspects and handcuffed them together. He was then attacked by a third suspect who hit him over the head several times with a brick and a firearm. The suspect then removed the officer's firearm and the three fled the scene leaving the officer in a pool of blood. The firearm magazine was found next to him after it ejected during the

scuffle." Teams from the security firm immediately went on a hunt for the suspects and they were arrested in KwaMashu not long after the robbery. The victim was treated at the scene and taken to hospital. Balram updated the Phoenix Sun on the progress of his officer and said that he is doing well but has currently lost his sense of balance due to the head injury.

FCS celebrate record number of sex offender arrests

The month of March saw members of the KZN FCS unit make 295 arrests in sex offender cases and 39 successful convictions. Various police units such as Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences Units come together to work as a team to secure the convictions and arrests. According to Provincial SAPS spokesman, Lt Nqobile Gwala, the dedicated teams have been working day and night on the various operations which led to the arrests. She said, "These dedicated team of detectives have been shuttling to and from the different courts throughout the province to see that justice is served in the highly sensitive cases of several victims of rape and sexual violation. From March 1 to March 31, the members arrested

a total of 295 suspects for sexual related offences including rape, sexual assault, statutory rape, attempted rape, violation of a protection order, child abandonment, child pornography and other cases. A total of 39 accused were convicted and sentenced by various courts in the province." Two life sentences were handed down to two accused and others were given a total of 415 years imprisonment. Other suspects are still in custody waiting for their cases to be heard at various courts. "This is the outcome of the commitment and hard work of dedicated investigating officers. The sentences meted out will serve as a deterrent to some potential rapists that the police, through its FCS units, are leaving no stones unturned," said Ngoben.

Ford Figo 1.5 Titanium PowerShift Auto

A sweet little sedan

The Ford Figo, as you doubtless already know, has gone and grown up. And grown up rather nicely at that.

The new model launched late last year is decidedly slicker, sleeker, bigger and bolder than its rather utilitarian predecessor which was really just a resurrected old Fiesta, but an affordable and hardy little car all the same.

Incidentally, I'm all for this business of resurrecting old models for the South African market, a trend that was started by VW with the CitiGolf back in the Eighties, and which we still see with vehicles such as the VW Polo Vivo and the Toyota Corolla Quest. Both worthy machines that make up what they lose on driver involvement with excellent value and robustness.

And let it not be forgotten that a large chunk - quite the possibility the majority - of the motoring public seeks not sharp styling and on-the-edge handling and adrenaline surges, but a machine that goes and stops in a regular, reliable manner.

Now I've just spent a week with the top-range Figo - a 1.5 Titanium PowerShift Auto Sedan, with the vehicle now being available in four-door guise as well as a hatchback, as before.

It's an attractive machine, even if its small 14-inch alloys do look a little shopping-trolley like. But perhaps the best news is that it comes with a proper

six-speed automatic gearbox. Not a CVT transmission, which is what so many manufacturers are fitting - presumably for cost reasons - to their smaller vehicles. In the process often ruining them, and I think of the likes of the Nissan Sentra and Honda Ballade, which are worthy machines but not when equipped with droning CVT gearboxes.

Powering the whole show is a normally aspirated 1.5-litre petrol unit (the previous model used a 1.4). It's a perfectly adequate motor with 82kW on tap. Not much by today's standard, but that's what the early Golf GTI's were making in the days of yore. Torque is 136Nm

at 4,250rpm, and the Figo will move from rest to 100km/h in an adequate 12 seconds, with a top speed of 175km/h. Claimed fuel consumption is six litres per 100km, but good luck with achieving that.

To make satisfactory progress in this machine you need to drive it hard, and it really cries out for Ford's brilliant, award-winning little turbopetrol EcoBoost motor. But for complex reasons that were explained to me by Ford, it's not getting it. Not anytime soon anyway.

Equipment levels are pretty good, and this top-spec Figo gets the likes of climate control specifically developed for

hot climates, and lashings of stowage space including plenty of cupholders, and a cubbyhole big enough to swallow a laptop. It will also swallow up to 445 litres of luggage, while the rear seats fold 60:40.

Plus you get good in-car connectivity, allowing you to interact with mobile devices and the entertainment system via voice commands. But some studies have shown that, hands free or not, driver attention is severely impacted by focusing on phones.

Safety is taken care of by six airbags, and this halo model also gets an Electronic Stability Programme (ESP), plus Hill Launch Assist.

Yours for R209,900. That includes a four-year/120,000km warranty, and a two-year/40,000km service plan. A worthy enough little Ford, this - even if it has kind of lost its price advantage.
