



As offered, this Model 51 also features the original Brown leather interior with only the seat cushions having been re-covered. A new top-quality Haartz top was fitted recently. Most mechanical systems have been gone through as well, making this wonderful Pierce a tour-ready car. Lovely, simple, and yet bold in its low and sleek lines of flowing beauty, it offers true form and function as a pure artwork on four wheels and simply must be experienced by anyone considering themselves a "true" classic-car enthusiast!



Oldsmobile was a leader and innovator of automobiles and advanced technology amongst the GM fleet. The first 442 was introduced in midyear 1964 with the B-09 police pursuit package option available on the Cutlass line. 4-4-2 designated, 4 barrel carburetor, 4 speed transmission and dual exhaust. The Oldsmobile 442 quickly earned its reputation as the Gentleman's Muscle car.

The top dog engine option for the 442 was option code W-30 and was introduced in 1966 as technically a Drag Race Option Package with only 54 being produced that year. All W-30 optioned 442s, for all years, were built at the Lansing Michigan plant. The 442 became its own model in 1968 and the VIN number of the car will designate that it is indeed a true 442 from 1968 up to and including 1971.

For the 1969 model year Oldsmobile Division featured Dr. Oldsmobile and his crew in advertisements to promote the special W-Machines. Dr. Oldsmobile was a parity of Dr. Frankenstein and became a popular and colorful cult character during the Muscle Car Era. The W-30 option on a 442 added some very impressive performance options on top of all the standard 442 goodies.

## 1982 ASTON MARTIN V8 VANTAGE COUPE CONSIGN # 8097 VIN # V8VOL12332

Highly acclaimed from launch in 1977, Aston Martin's brilliant V-8 Vantage was visually identified by aggressive cues including a blanked-off grille, bonnet air scoop, Cibié driving lamps, and deep frontal air dam. Its 5.3-liter Vantage-spec V-8 engine delivered some 425 horsepower and powered the car from rest to 60 mph in 5.4 seconds en route to a 170-mph top end. The "Oscar India" (October Introduction) variant debuted in 1978 with aerodynamic improvements including a neat bootlid spoiler and smoother bonnet. Just 313 examples of the V-8 Vantage were produced from 1977 through 1989.

Already very rare as one of just 172 Series 4 "Oscar India" V-8 Vantage models produced in all between 1979 and 1985, this very special example from 1982 was an original Canadian-delivery car with the "true" 425-horsepower Vantage specification, in contrast to US-specification "cosmetic Vantages," which do not possess the upgraded mechanicals and high-performance underpinnings of this car. According to Neil Thomas, president of West Coast Appraisals, "...there were probably only 3 or 4 Canadian-specification cars ever built. A car of this rarity does command a worldwide marketplace."

This "Oscar India" V-8 Vantage has incredible provenance as it was built for the consignor's late father Jack Pierce in late 1982 and imported to Calgary, Alberta in Canada.


A true 'supercar' boasting AMG's proprietary 563-horsepower 6.2-liter V-8 engine, the SLS AMG delivered an incredibly wide power band, 3.5-second sprints from rest to 60 miles per hour, and electrifying 11-second elapsed times in the quarter-mile en route to a 197-mph top-end charge. The SLS AMG GT variant delivered even greater performance potential with the AMG 6.2-liter engine fortified with another 20 horses bridled underhood. Torque remained unchanged at a stump-pulling 479 pounds-feet. The SLS AMG Roadster joined the stable for 2011 and provided unmatched open-air panache.

A Car and Driver magazine road test stated "At the track, though, the SLS is everything you'd expect of a \$200,000-plus car designed from the ground up by power-drunk AMG. We tested an SLS AMG GT coupe and roadster in back-to-back weeks, with the two cars posting nearly identical measurables."



# 1963 CHEVROLET CORVETTE CUSTOM SPLIT WINDOW

Based on a rare one-year-only 1963 "Split-Window" Corvette coupe, this awesome restomod has covered less than 400 miles since its completion in early 2014. It was purchased intact and ready for a planned body-off restoration with the idea of maintaining the history and beauty of an original '63 "Split-Window" coupe while adding the performance and creature comforts of a new Corvette.

A very rare LT5 engine and ZF 6-speed manual transmission were installed, with engine work and modifications performed by Marc Haibech and transmission work by Bill Beaudreau. The history and performance potential of this 440 horsepower LT5 engine ranks it among one of the most unique engines for Corvettes. The custom installation of the engine and associated parts includes a Ron Davis radiator with dual SPAL electric fans and custom paintwork throughout the engine compartment. The engineering to configure the placement of the engine was a feat taken on only by the best artisans in the restoration trade.


The Corvette's ride and handling was vastly improved with the custom-made chassis and C4 suspension assembled by the well-known Streetshops team in Alabama. The car is fitted with C2 custom side pipes with hydro boost power brakes, Vintage air conditioning, LineLoc parking brake, rack-and-pinion steering, power windows, and custom electrical wiring throughout. The Torch Red Al Knoch interior features C5 Corvette sport seats and custom paint with various appointments including a custom console. The driver and passenger dashes are of custom-made billet aluminum fitted with AutoMeter gauges on the driver's side. TKO Restorations of Tucson, Arizona performed the paint and bodywork. The exterior paint finish is a Chevrolet factory color called Cyber Gray Metallic, complemented by a 1967 big-block hood with a slightly different, silver-colored 'Stinger' and a 1967 rear backup light.

This awesome '32 Ford Pro Street Roadster features incredible attention to detail with most parts plated, polished, powder-coated, or stainless steel. The Deuce rides on a fully boxed Pro Street frame, highly modified to withstand the punishment from its 1,100 horsepower engine. The all-steel Brookville body features a custom grille shell and stainless-steel insert, plus a custom curved and polished Wanless windshield frame and custom recessed firewall, and the gloss black paint finish makes this vehicle's intentions perfectly clear.

Suspension is via dropped tubular front axles with a custom wishbone/4-link custom front suspension with transverse leaf spring, with the rear 4-bar setup complete with a diagonal track bar and coil-over shocks plus a 7/8-inch custom sway. Braking is handled by Wilwood 4-piston disc brakes all around with a fully polished Wilwood dual-circuit master cylinder, hidden Precision Electric vacuum-supply pump, and surgical-grade stainless brake lines. Custom Unisteer precision rack-and-pinion steering and Flaming River steering components round out the Deuce's underpinnings.



This final-year 1971 Mercedes-Benz 280SL convertible features a rare and highly desirable 4-speed manual transmission. It is a U.S. delivered car with two tops, factory air conditioning, and Becker radio. The exterior is magnificent dark blue with contrasting gray leather interior and grey soft-top. The exterior demonstrates all the hallmarks of an original "Pagoda," from the fender notches near inner headlight bezels to the uninterrupted factory spot welds around the engine bay. The trunk floor is original with all the correct indentations and the rear body panel still has its original factory spot welds. The car doesn't show any signs of an accident nor rust. The hood, trunk, and doors display excellent alignment and gaps. The hard top is complete with the rare factory chrome strips that would support specially-ordered ski racks.

Hutchinson Motors of Walnut Creek, CA sold the car new to Mary Lemmon, M.D. of San Francisco, CA. The second owner's 1990 title document stated the mileage was actual at 57,950. The car has been in long-term storage with stated mileage to be 62,247. The consignor, who is a known Mercedes restorer and collector, has nicely detailed the engine bay and undercarriage. He also states that the 280SL exhibits strong power and a smooth shifting manual transmission, which makes the car handle like the true classic sports car that it is. In short, this is a great car for shows, rallies, and everyday driving, equipped with the rare and most desirable 4-speed manual transmission.

A GM 700R4 overdrive automatic transmission provides cruising ease.

A limited-edition car with all-new gold grille and wheels, the Eldorado is finished in Red Metallic (originally white) with a new white vinyl top and red and white genuine leather interior. Medical-grade foam seat cushions provide excellent comfort and a clear plastic cover protects the new genuine leather upholstery. The original 325 horsepower dual-carburetor 365 V-8 is completely and professionally rebuilt and has 120 miles of use since completion. The consignor advises the vehicle runs and drives virtually perfectly and it has been tested and proven on more than one occasion, cruising fast on the road with no over heating with the AC running despite ambient temperatures exceeding 45 Celsius/128 Fahrenheit.

Built by renowned Woodie expert "Teddy Z" from Romulus, Michigan over two and half years, it features superior wood throughout with meticulous attention to detail and fit throughout. Subtle, tasteful custom touches include a completely reworked and smoothed 1941 Ford dash, perfectly fitted with timeless countersunk gauges, and a small-diameter tilt steering column from an early Chevy van with a tasteful welded and smoothed column drop topped off by a "Banjo" wheel. The interior features Tan Ultra-Naugahyde-upholstered seats, a beautiful Maple headliner and contrasting Maple and Mahogany door panels. Vintage Air and heat, plus an AM/FM CD stereo with hidden speakers complete the interior.


Subtle exterior mods include 1937 Ford taillights with hand-made stanchions, the rear bumper was moved up two inches, tucked in two inches, and fitted with a 1949 Chevy license frame that was narrowed by two inches. A custom 16-gauge gravel shield was fitted between the rear bumper and body. The rear window was lengthened 5/8-inch inch to eliminate the original rear rubber seal. The front bumper was narrowed four inches and tucked in by one inch. The fender trim was removed, welded, and metal finished for an overall smooth look.

The brand new 290 hp 350 cu. in. GM Goodwrench crate engine is outfitted with a Dura-shine Edelbrock intake and carb, and topped off with Billet Specialties dress-up items. It is mated to a new THM 350 automatic and coupled to an 8-inch Ford rear end with parallel leaf springs. The front suspension consists of a Mustang II front cross member mounted up one inch with dropped spindles and lowered coils. Rack-and-pinion steering and power disc brakes add modern drivability. The Black Haartz cloth top is super tight and fits like a glove. Super deep Black paint and the 18- and 20- inch Billet Specialties wheels finish off this amazing-looking, excellent running and driving Hot Rod Woodie.
