Family mourns child's death

The Theunissen family from Elsburg is battling to come to terms with the sudden death of one of their members, Christiaan (17).

The Grade 12 pupil was knocked down just outside the gates of Hoërskool Elsburg at about 6.30am on Wednesday.

The GCN visited the grieving family on Thursday, to talk to his parents, Pieter and Hester.

Pieter told the GCN that at the moment everything feels unreal, but they know they have to pick up the pieces and carry on.

He said that from what he understands of the events of the day, Christiaan was on his way to buy a cold drink and was crossing Parnell Road, at the zebra crossing, just outside the school.

"Witnesses said that a taxi stopped for him to cross, but, as he was walking, a woman in another vehicle did not stop and her car hit him," Pieter said.

Christiaan was critically injured and needed assistance to breathe, and had to be airlifted to the Charlotte Maxeke Johannesburg Academic

Hospital, where he died later that

William Ntladi, the media liaison officer for the Ekurhuleni Disaster and Emergency Management Services, said: "Upon arrival of the Ekurhuleni Emergency Services, the boy was diagnosed with severe head injuries and possible chest fractures by the paramedics on scene.

The helicopter had to be landed on the school sports grounds, in order to transport the child to hospital."

Pieter told the GCN that the EMPD and emergency services were excellent on the scene.

"We especially thank Netcare 911 and an off-duty paramedic, who stopped to assist Christiaan," Pieter said.

After the accident Christiaan's family were notified and they rushed to the scene.

One of Christiaan's friends, Ruan Ackermann, a matric pupil at Hoërskool Elspark, stayed with Christiaan's parents and assisted them until they got to the hospital.

Pieter told the GCN that Christiaan suffered severe brain trauma, an injury to his head and multiple bruises.

After conducting numerous tests he was declared brain dead at about 2.15pm.

"There was one small consolation, in that we were told, at the hospital, that Christiaan's end was more than likely immediate," said Pieter.

"I wouldn't have wanted him to

'This is very difficult; no parent should have to bury a child."

After they were told that Christiaan was brain dead, his parents decided to donate Christiaan's organs.

Christiaan Theunissen (17) died after being knocked down by a vehicle outside the gates of Hoërskool Elsburg, in Parnell Road, Elsburg, on Wednesday.

"I am an organ donor myself and Christiaan and I had discussed it and he said he would also like to donate his organs someday," Pieter said.

"We decided that his tragic death could, perhaps, help other people by giving them life."

Pieter described Christiaan as an enthusiastic, friendly, quiet child, an average scholar, who was very good at rugby and aspired to be an aircraft designer.

He played the position of wing for both his school and for the Germiston Simmer Rugby Club.

"He loved to make jokes and was always full of beans," Pieter

"He never got into fights and was just a normal 17-year-old, full of nonsense, who enjoyed

Christiaan's siblings, brothers Pieter (12) and Dewald (10), and sister Xonia (7), are distraught at the loss of their brother.

"Last night I showed Xonia the stars and said that's where Christiaan is now, looking down on us," Pieter said.

He has arranged counselling for the children.

With regard to the woman who knocked Christiaan over, Pieter told the GCN that it is not going to help them being angry with her.

"Anger is not going to bring our son back; we will now let the law take its course," he said.

"Every day when she sees a child, or drives past a school, she is going to remember the accident and she must live with this.

"That is going to be her biggest punishment."

The family thanks Hoërskool Elsburg for holding a memorial service for Christiaan on Thursday morning, and for all the support staff and pupils at the school have given the family.

"They have gone above and beyond with their support," Pieter said.

He also thanks Ram Couriers, the company for which he and Hester work and who have supported them all the way and are taking care of the funeral costs.

"I had managers from the company constantly at my side at the hospital and I thank them for their great support and assistance," Pieter said.

He added that the family has also experienced an incredible outpouring of support from the community, which they really appreciate.

Christiaan's funeral will be held at the NG Kerk Elsburg Central in Kerk Street at 11am on Thursday (tomorrow).

Lieut Col Zonele Patrick Qangase, acting station commander for the Elsburg SAPS, told the GCN that a case has been registered with them and they are cur-

Juan Strydom told the GCN that people use Parnell Road like a "race track'

"We must act now, how many more children must be hurt or, even worse, robbed of their lives, before something is done," he said.

"What happened on Wednesday must never happen again.

"I drove past the scene and couldn't help thinking this could have been my child."

Another person, who lives in Parnell Road, commented that both cars and bikes race up and down the road.

"It is high time something gets done about it," they added.

"What about speed bumps that will definitely slow them down?"

The GCN contacted both the metro and the EMPD with regard to the matter and what can be done to prevent future accidents.

Wilfred Kgasago, the EMPD spokesman said: "I will forward the complaints regarding speeding to our Speed Unit commander for action and, in respect of speed bumps being erected, the department of roads and civil works will be requested to look into the matter."

Themba Gadebe, spokesman for the metro, said: "The provision of speed humps will be evaluated by the metro's roads planning division in terms of council policies and guidelines.

"If speed humps are warranted, they will be implemented. Feedback will be given regarding the evaluation.

The said road will be inspected and corrective measures will be taken."





Cleansing levy frustrates residents

The GCN has received a number of calls regarding the "area cleansing levy" on their municipal accounts.

An amount of R5 is being charged to residents on a monthly basis.

Eric Palm, a resident of Malvern East, said: "I presume it is for cleansing the area.

"However, I work from home and have stayed in my house for the last 25 years and have never seen a cleaner clean the area outside my home.

"Can someone shed some light on this subject and be more specific about why we are paying the levy?"

Another Germiston resident, Barry Taylor, said that as far as he was aware part of your rates go towards cleaning your area.

Taylor had the following questions regarding the levy:

☐ Is there a monthly schedule, similar to the one for solid waste collection (you need to know when your area will be cleaned)?

☐ What will we actually get from this levy? ☐ Is there a "hotline" where you can phone in and ask for area cleansing?

☐ Does this cover cleaning/sweeping of the street and cleaning of the rain gutters?

☐ Does it cover the removal of weeds on the pavements, etc?

Does it include picking up and removing general rubbish thrown down by people in the street?

☐ Does it include removal of notices from street lights?

☐ Do the cleaners empty the waste bins at the corners of junctions?

"The above are all areas which I would say fall under the term 'area cleansing'," Taylor said.

"These are questions that the metro should detail/answer before implementing the levy.

"I have no problem paying this extra levy, as long as it is controlled and the ratepayer gets something out of it to make Germiston and the rest of the metro cleaner for all.

"The by-laws for dumping of rubbish should also be enforced."

A resident of Elspark has also queried the levy.

She said her area has never been cleaned and she doesn't understand why residents are paying a levy when no work is being done.

The GCN asked the metro for comment on the matter and Themba Gadebe, from the department of communications and brand management, said: "Please note that council is going to address the cleansing levy in the adjustment budget.

"The intention is that, with the withdrawal of the R5 levy and the correction of the 15 per cent tariff increase, customers will not be worse off."

The metro did not explain the levy or the thinking behind it, or tell the GCN if areas are, in fact, cleaned.



The barrier has not yet been repaired and is a danger to pedestrians, as well as motorists. The GCN asked the metro when the barrier would be repaired and why this has not yet been done, but, at the time of going to press, no comment had been received.

Germiston South to experience water shutdown

The metro is informing its consumers in the Germiston South industrial area of a planned water shutdown, scheduled for today, Wednesday, February 12, from 8am until 3pm.

The water technicians will be connecting a 150mm water meter pipe for the acid mine drainage plant situated in Germiston South.

As a result, areas within that vicinity will experience lower water pressure or complete water shutdown.

The affected areas include Good Hope informal settlement, Strachan Street, Jack Pienaar Street, Lower Boksburg Road and Knights Road.



Summiting a mountain to feed children

The Feed a Family Organisation is registered as a non-profit organisation, with the Department of Social Services.

The group's mission is to feed as many underprivileged families as possible and it encourages fellow citizens to assist in feeding at least one family every month, as it costs a mere R15 to feed an entire family for a whole day.

"Ultimately, we seek to empower the impoverished and spread our reach to as many needy South Africans as possible," said chairman Malcolm Poovan.

"We currently supply necessities, like milk, bread and pap, on a monthly basis, at the Maccau informal settlement in the east of Johannesburg.

"Our overriding motivation is to alleviate poverty and reduce crime (through skills development and empowerment)," said chairman Malcolm Poovan.

"Startling statistics illustrate that more than three million children in South Africa are hungry every day."

The Feed a Family Organisation's project for 2014 is the Feed a Learner EPS Project, which is to provide daily lunch to approximately 1 350 impoverished pupils at Ekurhuleni Primary School (EPS) for this year.

The school is situated in Dukathole, an informal settlement in the industrial hub of Germiston.

"This poverty-ridden informal settle-

ment, marred by high unemployment and crime rates, is home to mainly women and children," said Poovan.

"It will cost R4 per day (R20 per week) to feed one pupil a nutritious daily meal.

"In line with our overall vision and mission we ultimately want to empower the pupils and teachers of EPS with personal skills development, and the Dukathole residents with sustainable organic farming tools and knowledge,' said Poovan.

To give the project the kick-start it needs, The Climb, a fund-raising initiative involving a comedian, a mountaineer and a lawyer, is taking place.

The three passionate South African ambassadors, namely Tshepo Mogale, Sibusiso Vilane and Tebogo Kwape are currently (February 10 to 13) climbing Mount Kilimanjaro (at 5 895m high it is the world's tallest freestanding mountain) to promote awareness and raise money for the Feed a Learner EPS Project.

The purpose of The Climb is also to shed light on the plight of hungry children in South Africa and how we, as citizens, can get involved and offer our help to children in need.

Tshepo Mogale is a local celebrity, stand-up comedian, writer and producer, whose notable works include the Smirnoff Comedy Blackout, the Joe Parker Comedy Express circuit and being published in the Urban Writers Series, among other things.

Sibusiso Vilane is a motivational and inspirational speaker, mountaineer and expedition guide and leader.

He was the first black African to summit Mount Everest and the seven peaks of the world and is the author of the book "To the Top from Nowhere", among other accomplishments.

Tebogo Kwape is an attorney and partner at Kwape Matritz (MKM) Attorneys.

He has been a police reservist since 2007 and is a member of the SAPS Rifle Club.

"Our goal is to raise R1.5-million," said Poovan.

"With this amount we will be able to provide daily lunch to the 1 350 impoverished pupils at EPS for the whole year.

"In order to reach our target, we are looking for 1 500 individuals/ companies to pledge R100 a month to sponsor a pupil for the Feed a Learner EPS Project.'

The race was predominantly a K2 15km race with over 51 boats on the water.

Although the race was mainly a K2 event, there were K1 paddlers who had their own race start just five minutes after the K2s.

With vests handed out to entrants,

medals for category winners, free meals, and a DG Capital Investment of prize money, the race was bound to be a success.

Michael Stewart and Brandon Collyer won the event and were also first in the Veteran age category in one hour, 10 minutes and 44 seconds, while seconds later brought in Alex Roberts and Robert Crichton, in second place.

Thembinkosi Ngcobo and Tom Ngcobo were less than a second behind, to take third place.

It was a very tight finish.

The u-18 team of Siyabonga Tyiki and Simnikiwe Ntondini were fifth overall, only 10 seconds behind

the front bunch, and the first Sub-Veterans, Serge van Hee and Jeromy Dacey, finished eighth, in one hour, 12 minutes and 38 seconds.

Tsidiso Bobo and Mfundo Sithole were the first u-23s home, in ninth place, just half a minute later.

The Sub-Master team of Franz Lottering and Vallon Kupferberg finished as the 23rd K2 team, in one hour and 17 minutes, and the youngest paddler to finish the race was Alex Masina, as the seventh K1 entrant, in one hour and 21 minutes.

Masters winners were Zach Zacharopoulos and Josh Loots, in one hour and 23 minutes.

"This was a great race; it went well, all the paddlers did their best and one can only predict great results at the Dusi," said the Victoria Lake Canoe Club's vice-chairman, Dorian Pretorius.

For VLC, the Dusi will be another great way to end the season.

"Our season is coming to end and will start again in April, so we have the Dusi and the Umko Race in March," said Pretorius.

"The Umko is a big water race, that is more technical, and we are eagerly looking forward to both events.

"We had a great season, with a couple of great races, and we thank our partner, Ekurhuleni, for the support.

Corolla gets new lines

eet Joe, a 42-year-old married male with his 2.5 children. What does Joe drive? A Toyota Corolla.

You might think his car is bland, yet functional. Yes, we all may have our gripes about the 'dull' Corolla, but there's obviously something inherently charming about it seeing that it's the best-selling

And now the next-generation Corolla - just launched in South Africa - promises to ooze a lot more character than Joe's daily runaround.

You see, the eleventh generation Corolla is a lot more assertive in its styling, particularly in the front end as it embraces the Furia concept. This new offering has really grown into its body and apart from aesthetic considerations, the interior space has been reworked to offer customers a more spacious and comfortable ride.

From a styling perspective, the Corolla has truly been ushered into the modern era with the upper grille and the headlamps made as thin as possible to emphasise the width of the body while the chrome horizontal trim bars of the upper grille are visually extended into more expressive headlamp clusters.

At the rear, the trapezoidal form found in the front of the vehicle also makes an appearance, with the boot lip complemented by the new rear

For a sedan, the Corolla has more curves than a pregnant Kardasian, which is great for aerodynamics and achieving minimum drag levels.

The talking point of any Corolla will be the cockpit and the practicality it offers through interior space. The redesigned cabin now boasts superior trim materials and enhanced ergonomics. Boot capacity has increased to 452 litres.

The new Corolla is not only more spacious and comfortable, but also quieter than its predecessor as the interior has been designed to offer customers class-leading quietness.

Through a robust and uncluttered clarity, the Corolla is finished off by chrome trim and high-gloss

It's a combination that works and the added tech enhances the driver's comfort. Some of these features include remote central locking, touch-screen radio, USB and Bluetooth along with cruise control (depending on the derivative).

Powering the new generation of Corollas is a choice of four engines. The 1.3-litre petrol engine



produces a generous 73kW of power and 128Nm of torque, which translates into a 0-100km/h time of 12.6 seconds and a top speed of 180km/h. A laudable fuel consumption of just 6.0 litres/100km is attainable in the combined cycle and CO₂ emissions of 139g/km is achieved.

For those wanting more bang, the 1.6-litre petrol engine develops 90kW and 154Nm, available in both manual and Multidrive CVT automatic guises. Acceleration times are 10.5 seconds and 11.1 seconds, respectively. Maximum speed is 195km/h and 185km/h.

When equipped with the manual transmission, the unit returns a combined cycle fuel consumption of just 6.6 litres/100km and emits 157g/km of CO₂. The new Multidrive S auto transmission further reduces both fuel consumption and emissions to 6.3 litres/100km and 150g/km, respectively.

Replacing the 2.0-litre petrol of the outgoing model is a new 1.8-litre unit fitted to top-end models. This powertrain produces 103kW and 173Nm of torque.

The 0-100km/h dash is dispensed with in 10.2 seconds for the Multidrive Svariant. Top speed is recorded as 195km/h (figures for the 1.8 manual are not yet available).

What we do know about the manual 1.8 is that it consumes on average just 7.0 litres/100km and emits 165g/km of CO₂. Equipped with the new Multidrive S transmission, the unit returns a combined cycle fuel consumption of 6.4 litres/100km and generates CO₂ emissions of only 152g/km.

Probably the biggest talking point is the appearance of the new 1.4-litre D-4D diesel engine. Developing 66kW and maximum torque of 205Nm, it propels the Corolla from standstill to 100km/h in 12.5 seconds and has a maximum speed of 180km/h. Equipped with Toyota's standard sixspeed manual transmission, the 1.4 D-4D returns a class-best combined-cycle fuel consumption of just 4.5 litres/100km and generates CO₂ emissions of only 119g/km.

The new Corolla develops exactly what its predecessor offered - practical commuting at an affordable price. But the new Corolla does it a little differently, because it delivers it with a personality. Not everyone grows up wanting to own a Corolla, but when they do, it becomes a companion for life.

Pricing of the new Corolla will start at R214 000 for the 1.3 Esteem and the range-topping 1.8 Exclusive Multidrive S will retail for R283 900.

The new Corolla comes standard with a 3-year/100000km warranty and 5-year/90000km service plan.

New X5 a truly exquisite machine

ASTUTE and luxurious, the all-new BMW X5 promises to take premium SUV motoring to a new level.

Yes, muttering the word BMW is synonymous with luxury and while the German powerhouse might argue that the X5 isn't an SUV but rather an SAV (sport activity vehicle) - the first of its kind - there's no denying it's an absolutely lavish beast that commands impressive attention and is a popular model. The proof is in the sales figures, where one out of every five BMWs sold is an X5.

So what's changed with the new model? Well, you might be forgiven for thinking very little, but upon closer inspection you realise this German has an entirely new facade. The familiar kidney grille has been enlarged and now meets the twin circular headlights to give it a more pronounced long stretched silhouette is complemented by the swage line over the wheel arches.

At the rear the changes are again subtle, as the car retains the horizontal lines emphasised by the robust stance of the X5, while the new thin, threedimensional LED light strips of the two-section L-shaped rear lights create a striking night-time

Preserving the distinctive X5 physique, the new model's interior is generously sized and the renowned elegance can be found throughout the

Some of the welcomed changes inside include the ambient lighting designs and redesigned instrument cluster while the clear 10.2-inch control display screen is now freestanding and moves away from the one previously integrated into the dashboard design.

It's a car fit for a king that isn't flashy and wants

look. The exterior is imposing and elegant as the functionality, because this BMW isn't just a pavement hopper and in fact does boast some off-road credentials, as we experienced on the launch.

> We got to play in the dirt and while the X5 is by no means a fully-fledged off-roader but this lavishly suited vehicle made short work of the dusty and sandy roads given its tall stance and powerful

> But where it really shines is on the black stuff as it prances and floats about in its luxury attire, transporting its passengers in utmost comfort.

> Currently, there are three powertrains on offer. The sublimely economical xDrive30d, with its six-cylinder in-line diesel engine incorporates a range of detail improvements. The 3.0-litre engine now develops maximum power of 190kW (up by 10kW) and maximum torque of 560Nm (up by 20Nm). Capable of doing the 0-100km/h sprint in a claimed 6.9 seconds, it will also average 6.2 litres/100km.

For those looking for a little more gusto, the sporty xDriveM50d gets a 3.0-litre straight-six unit, in this case featuring M Performance Twin-Power Turbo technology with three-stage turbocharging. This engine has a maximum output of 280kW and develops peak torque of 740Nm. It charges to 100km/h in just 5.3 seconds and has a claimed fuel consumption of 6.7 litres/100km.

For the power hungry among us, the xDrive50i is the pick of the bunch. Utilising the new-generation V8 engine, it generates 330kW of power and 650Nm of torque and will complete the 0-100km/h shuffle in five seconds while drinking around 10.4 litres/100km of fuel.

The BMW X5 line-up will expand later. The X5 xDrive35i (225 kW) will be released as well as the xDrive40d (230 kW).

Pricing for the new BMW X5 range starts at R769 900 and includes as standard the company's 5-year/100 000km Motorplan.

Here comes the Sonic boom

HOT HATCHES are for many people the only feasible way to enter the world of high-performance vehicles. The only problem is that these cars are often quite a bit more expensive than the plain, vanilla models in the rest of the range and - in their pursuit of speed - can often be compromised in terms of comfort and daily usability.

This is where the new Chevrolet Sonic RS comes in. It has no intention of being labelled a hot hatch, according to its makers. The RS nomenclature it wears is in many other brands a symbol of the epitome of high performance. However, in the case of Chevrolet, the RS badge equates to the same thing as the S in Audi's range or the M Sport in the BMW range. There are still the SS

and Z model designations above that of the RS in Chevrolet's range.

So a lukewarm hatch it is, the figures tell a similar story. A 1.4-litre turbocharged engine as seen in the Cruze and Opel Astra powers the RS. It produces 103kW and 200Nm. Of particular importance is the claimed fuel consumption figure of 6.6 litres/100km with carbon emissions of 155g/km.

The claimed 0-100km/h time of 9.5 seconds and the top speed of 197km/h sound relatively tame, but the car does have a very decent turn of speed. The engine pulls strong all the way to 6 000rpm and there is hardly any sign of lag, meaning that the performance is accessible in both open-road overtaking as well as in urban situations.

Looks-wise, the RS certainly sets itself apart from the rest of the range with a more sporty front bumper and new fog light design. There are fivespoke 17-inch alloys finished in gunmetal, which are complemented by new side skirts and blackpainted door mirrors with LED indicators. The rear lights have taken inspiration from the world of motorcycling. There is also a roof spoiler and at the bottom a diffuser that is offset by a large single exit exhaust.

The interior has received some treatment in the form of red accents on the leather-bound steering wheel. The steering wheel, seat piping, floor mats and rev counter all receive RS badging. The seats are half leather and half suede to exude a sporty look - there are even aluminium foot pedals to evoke the inner boy racer.

Perhaps the most important feature of the RS is the new MyLink infotainment system. The unit is basically a central information hub comprising of many infotainment functions. The touch screen also features buttons to return the user to the home screen or to power off the unit with the option of controlling everything without the need to take a hand off the steering wheel.

The system feels like it belongs in a car costing far more, the smartphone integration is impressive with support for Bluetooth as well as USB. Users with iPhones, for example, can even run apps on the seven-inch screen and stream podcasts, international radio stations or even give Siri a command. In terms of a USB, there is the option to watch videos or even scroll through pictures when the vehicle is stationary.

Pricing was always going to be the most important aspect of the RS and at R225 300 it competes directly with the nimble Suzuki Swift Sport without straying into Peugeot 208 GTi and Ford Fiesta ST territory. With a 3-year/60 000km service plan and 5-year/120 000km warranty, I believe that Chevrolet has a winner with the new Sonic RS.



Simoncelli an official legend

ITALIAN rider Marco Simoncelli is to be inducted into the Hall of Fame as a MotoGP Legend. The popular former 250cc world champion was a frontrunner in the premier class before tragically losing his life in 2011 at the Sepang MotoGP in Malaysia.

In becoming a MotoGP Legend, Simoncelli's name will be the 21st on the list. The Gresini rider lost his life on 23 October 2011 in a crash on the second lap of the Malaysian Grand Prix, just one week after finishing in second place at Phillip Island.

The Italian rider dazzled the world championship paddock with his charisma, ability and racing style and was a world champion, having taken the 250 crown in 2008, a title he narrowly missed out on defending in 2009.

Arriving in the premier class in 2010, his progress was rapid and before his untimely death, Simoncelli had already taken two premier-class podiums and two poles in a strong second campaign.

Simoncelli's introduction as a MotoGP Legend will take place at this year's Italian Grand Prix at Mugello, as he joins a list that already includes compatriot Giacomo Agostini, Mick Doohan, Geoff Duke, Wayne Gardner and Mike Hailwood.





NIGGLES WITH ROUNDABOUTS

Dear Editor,

I agree with the sentiments expressed in your article Roundabouts can turn problems around in week 5's issue. The idea of roundabouts is good, especially because they have no moving parts and need no power supply.

However, I feel there are a few problems:

- As far as I know, South Africa is the only 'roundabouted' country that has two sets of roundabout rules, depending on whether or not the centre is painted yellow. And the 'average' motorist seems either to ignore the (undesirable) distinction or to choose whichever one suits him or her. Usually, 'first come first served' while 'give way to the right' should be the rule at all times
- The roads in South African towns (with the possible exception of Welkom) were not designed with roundabouts in mind. The roads themselves are too narrow and the intersections are too small. This is especially difficult for the drivers of buses or large vehicles such as delivery trucks (this apparently doesn't worry many of the large SUV drivers, who just barge across the hump in the middle anyway)

I just read the article on roundabouts being effec-

tive in America. I laughed out loud at the prospect

of them being brought in bulk to our country.

• The cavalier attitude in general of South African drivers for the rules of the road, often dictated by the size of the vehicle being driven - again, especially SUVs and the like. It's exemplified by the performance at traffic lights, where green means 'go', amber means 'accelerate' and red mean 'floor it!'

 Apart from squatting behind speed-trapping cameras, the traffic police seems to do very little to encourage or enforce observance of the road rules

• With an estimated 80% of driving licences being fake and no periodic roadworthy checks, our roads are virtual minefields and generally quite terrifying to drive on.

MORE COMMENTS ON ROUNDABOUTS

Traffic circles, if used correctly, will definitely ease congestion. But therein lies the rub - South African motorists are far too aggressive and will forge ahead at all costs, not giving way to traffic on the right. - Hilton Carroll

Traffic circles may stop the annoyance of out-oforder robots, but I go through a few traffic circles to and from work every day and not many people pay attention to them. Some even fly through them at full speed and if the other person was in the same bad habit, they have a potential of major accidents. - Anonymous

It would alleviate the problem of traffic lights not working. The traffic reports in the morning would be much shorter as they would not have to report all the traffic lights which are not working. Anonymous

The government won't have to spend oodles of money on maintenance, or (often promised but not always delivered) traffic officers to direct traffic at dead lights. Speed bumps can appear overnight, so I doubt traffic circles would be that big a deal. - Jill du Plessis

Traffic circles would certainly help traffic flow in those smaller junctions currently controlled by traffic lights, where one sits in a queue while the side road on green has no traffic exiting. However, is it going to make much difference or only exasperate the problems at major junctions like Grosvenor Crossing and Clay Oven. I believe that the answer for these large junctions is 'flyovers', but will they ever be considered? - Billy Reide

I agree that traffic circles can improve the flow of traffic if planned properly. But if you want to see how bad planning can cause traffic congestion, come view the peak hour and weekend flow at the traffic circle on First Road, Bardene, Boksburg. They have also utilised traffic circles to cope with the problem. One circle has about nine roads going off it and operates very effectively. - **Anonymous**

If we intend to construct more traffic circles as proposed by Stuart Moir, then the public must be educated in their use before implementation. I was in Massachusetts, USA in 1998. At the time they introduced roundabouts and there was a massive television campaign explaining how to use them. That campaign ran for some weeks before the roundabouts into use. We must do the same.

The basic rules of a roundabout are to indicate on approach in the same manner as if you are approaching a regular intersection, yield to traffic to the right, and exit with caution. On approaching a double-lane roundabout, you enter in the left or outer lane only if you are taking the next exit off. If you are taking the second or third exit you enter on the right or inner lane and at your exit you go off on the correct lane. If you are in the inside lane, anyone in the outside lane will in theory be turning off with you at your turn off in the left lane.





The realities of everyday taxi life



Taxis are part of our daily lives. We cannot survive without them and this is also true for taxi drivers, whose bread and butter is to ferry people around

We receive numerous complaints about taxis on a weekly basis. In fact, this issue features so strongly that in a recent poll on our website, 90% of voters said that the government must spend most of the traffic department's resources on taxi offences. This is magnified by the fact that the e-toll violations processing centre, blue light brigade and drinking and driving combined for the other 10%.

We decided this week, however, to look at the other side of the coin: what taxi life is like, for better or worse.

Every morning, I - like 15 million others - catch a taxi to work and I must admit that it's exciting, but also frightening at times. Unlike buses, the smaller carriage load enables taxis to go back and forth and in most cases that's where the problem starts, as they rush to be first ones to board passengers and in the process offend other road users. However, the reason they rush is because most of these taxi drivers' employers give them specific targets they must reach each day. So the question to motorists is: if you were in their shoes, wouldn't you do the same?

In a taxi, some passengers greet and chat away, thus bringing about a spirit of community, something you don't experience when driving

alone in a car. The exciting thing is that friendships that are created among passengers can last outside the taxi for years.

What I like about taxis is the time I can use to do something else. So instead of having a driver's stress and spending time behind the wheel that they'll never get back, as a passenger I use this time to read a newspaper to stay abreast with all that's happening around the world.

However, a journey by taxi isn't always as pleasant as it may sound. Some taxis are open graves, with broken windows, worn seats, cracked windscreens and doors that require specialised jigs to

It is a fact that some taxis are overloaded and needless to say, it is the drivers' fault. Some late passengers insist on being squeezed into a full taxi and although some drivers are very strict, others will allow this in order to reach their daily targets. These situations can also be merciless, because if you are already on board and have a problem with this, it is expected of you to simply get

The other negative and most complained about by motorists is driver negligence, like stopping in the middle of a lane, cutting in front of other drivers and driving in the yellow lane or passing a red robot. Passengers are sometimes unreasonable in instructing the driver to stop in places where it's not appropriate for them to do so. It's also a very common and easy excuse for taxi drivers to drive the way they do, but in actual fact, they drive like this anyway, full taxi or not.

All of these issues also bring about a frightening reality for some of these drivers: dodging the metro police. They do this on daily basis, but if they are caught and are lucky, a bribe or a Coke will get them out of trouble.

The darkest aspect of taxi life is also one that most motorists don't have to deal with and thus not really think about: the taxi wars. It is widely believed that these disputes only affect those involved, but in fact they do impact and disrupt the whole

community. Many civilian lives have been lost due to these wars. The aftermath also don't just affect association members. Many commuters are left stranded and for many, this usually means 'no

Probably the biggest misconception around taxi life is that it's responsible for the most road deaths. However, according to the 2010/2011 annual traffic report, 405 people died in crashes involving minibus taxis while a massive 6 649 were killed in car accidents. This means that for each road death in a minibus taxi, 16 people were killed in accidents involving cars.

What is exciting, though, is that transformation is taking place, however slow it might be. The industry is becoming regulated - members of the Ivory Park Taxi Association are now expected to wear ties on Mondays and Fridays. The aim is to promote professionalism and neatness among the drivers.

When asked about the significance of wearing a tie, Xolani Zulu, who's route goes from Ivory Park to Kempton Park, said, "This enables other taxi drivers to bath and be neat." This may seem trivial to the average motorist, but in the taxi community, it's a big step in the right direction. And in my view, the change in dress code will completely work if it can be applied five days a week.

In essence, every taxi is a death trap, but so is every other vehicle on the road. Many complaints about taxis are founded and completely valid, but for most of us, it is part of our daily lives. We cannot survive without them and this is also true for taxi drivers, whose bread and butter is to ferry people around.

Remember, for every taxi driver that makes your blood boil, there are 15 other people whose livelihood depend on them. And in the end I can't make excuses. I can just tell my story.
