Alleged robbery suspect beaten by angry mob

KINROSS - The shack that belongs to a resident who was alleged to have been found stealing in Marikana, was destroyed by an angry mob and he was ordered to vacate the area.

Residents said two men were seen trying to break into the shack of a resident who was at work.

Those who have witnessed the alleged crime, blew whistles and community members chased the two men.

They caught one and beat him.

Residents demanded that he showed them where he had stored the stolen goods.

The man finally told them that his friend asked him to help him carry the stolen goods to one of the shops in Afghanistan and some

were stored in his one room shack.

The shack was opened and some people managed to identify their stolen clothes and cell phones, among others.

The police finally managed to rescue the man and he was taken to the hospital.

One of the women on the scene said the man and his friend tried to forcefully open her shack without knowing that she was inside.

They ran away when they realised she was inside.

Acting Station Commander, Mr Percy Matlala, said the alleged suspect was taken to the hospital after he was beaten by the community.

He said charges have not been laid yet.

'Our house is falling apart'

KINROSS - The lives of two young women who live on their own are a misery, because their RDP house is falling apart day by day.

The oldest sister said she played a motherly role to her younger sister immediately after the death of their mother in 2010.

The *Ridge Times* visited the family twice and the first time, the reporter found the younger sister sitting on her bed and the whole house was flooded after a rain fall.

The water seeped through the bricks and the foundation.

"This is how we live, but my older sister is still at work," said the younger sister who cannot speak properly because of a speech impediment.

The windows are all broken and she said when it rains or there is a storm, the house shakes and the windows break.

The bricks of the house are also falling one by one and all they can do, is to pray that the house does not fall on them.

The second time that the *Ridge Times* visited the family, the younger sister and her two-year-old son were sitting in the dark and next to the door was a 10kg bag of mealie meal and 2kg of washing powder that she had received from a neighbour.

Ms Sibongile Shabangu, the older sister, is currently employed at the Expanded Public Works Programme, but the salary does not allow her to support them as most of the money go for transport.

The *Ridge Times* visited the family twice and the first time, the reporter found the younger sister sitting on her bed and the whole house was flooded after a rain fall

"I am grateful for the work, because it gives me experience and also helps to keep me busy rather than sitting at home, but the salary is not enough to buy food.

"I use the money to buy clothes and food for my younger sister's son, because the father is nowhere to be found," said Ms Shabangu.

The younger sister does not get a foster grant, because she does not have an identity document and her son does not have a birth certificate, so he also does not get a child grant.

The two sisters have been trying to get the birth certificate for the younger sister for years, but to no avail.

When asked about the electricity, Ms Shabangu said she does not know what went wrong, because the meter box was no longer working properly.

She reported it to the municipality and on their arrival, they removed it and said she bridged electricity.

"They say I must pay R6 000 to get reconnected, but I do not have it.

"Having no electricity is really affecting us and my younger sister who has special needs, including being a slow learner, uses candles to study," said Ms Shabangu.

Ms Shabangu said the Vukanini Taxi Association and their neighbours are helping them with groceries, though they do not get it every month.

She further said the neighbours have always been there for them after the death of their mother.

One of the orphanages assisted by helping to register her younger sister in school and they are also looking after her son.

"All I wish for, is for the house to be fixed."
