Furore over task team's disbanding

The Brakpan SAPS has disbanded its Anti-Hijacking Task Team - a decision that has many members of the community up in arms.

The task team, renowned for its policing successes, was informed of the decision by Brakpan Police Station management on Thursday last week.

Capt Joep Joubert, spokesperson for the Brakpan Police Station commander, initially told the Herald that the decision was made "in the interest of the employer and for better service delivery to the community".

The team comprised WO Jan Roos, WO Sonja Roos, Sgt Ockert Venter and Const Jacques Vivier, regarded by many as top cops.

It has since been alleged that members of the Brakpan CPF, a structure within the police service, laid complaints against the team, resulting in the disbanding.

These allegations were repeated during a community demonstration in protest of the decision, which was held on Monday morning outside the local police station.

While the gathering was peaceful, it was deemed illegal as the participants did not have permission.

About 50 residents were present and many blamed the CPF for the disbanding.

These residents also questioned the CPF's power in the community and claimed that CPF members "think they are police officers".

Police station management also came under fire.

The protesting residents held up placards reading 'Brakpan het die taakspan nodig', 'Top cops must

stay' and 'Taakspan sukses'.

Numerous residents believe that crime will now spike as a result of the disbanding.

Asked to comment on the allegations, Brakpan police confirmed that a complaint has been lodged by members of the CPF against the task team members.

"The identity of the complainants cannot be disclosed for the safety of the individuals," said Joubert.

The nature of the complaint can also not be said at this stage for the purpose of investigation; the disclosure can jeopardise the investigation."

Joubert explained the role of the

CPF and station management under fire for Brakpan Anti-Hijacking Task Team's disbanding.

"The CPF is a structure established under the Police Act and the function is to facilitate a mutual understanding between the SAPS and the public, to listen to the complaints of the public and liaise with the police to address the complaints," he said.

On the other hand, the function is to liaise with the public on feedback from the SAPS and to convey concerns of the police to the public.

"This is an exercise of ensuring that there is a partnership between the police and the community with the view of preventing crime.

"Nothing prevents the CPF from being in the company of police in projects like crime awareness and addressing the youth about drugs.

'We all have responsibilities as police and the public in ensuring that there is order in society.

"The CPF members can be at a roadblock with police.

"What I can say in regards to some concerns from the public is that the CPF has no powers to hold a roadblock on their own and search people.

"Any person who takes the law into his or her hands will be investigated and arrested at some stage."

According to Joubert, the disbanded team members will be working relief duty and will still be helping the community.

Whether the members will be replaced and a new task team will patrol the streets of Brakpan, Joubert stated that this will be taken into consideration.

"If the team is replaced it will not be now or soon," he said.

Joubert reminded residents that the SAPS, like any other government department, has rules and regulations to run the administration.

"The rules and regulations are not applied in a mala fide (bad faith) practice as there are procedures,' he said.

"These procedures need to be respected like in any company or

Two hijacked vehicles recovered

Two hijacked vehicles were recovered by members of the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Police Department (EMPD) over the weekend.

On Saturday, EMPD Equestrian Unit members recovered a white Ford Bantam bakkie that was hijacked in Brakpan the previous night.

The vehicle was found abandoned at around 11am.

"Through the assistance of a vehicle tracking system, the hijacked vehicle was recovered along Motlareng Street in KwaThema," said EMPD spokesperson Lieut-Col Wilfred Kgasago.

The vehicle was found intact with its original licence disc and registration plates untouched.

The owner of the vehicle was not harmed during the hijacking.

Once the forensics were completed, the vehicle was taken to SAPS Van Ryn Deep Pound in Benoni.

On Sunday morning, a hijacked white BMW 1 Series was recovered by members of the EMPD First Responder Unit.

The owner was hijacked of his vehicle along Mbhele Street in Langaville Extension Seven, in Tsakane, on Saturday night.

"The metro police came across the vehicle while patrolling the area and on enquiry received confirmation of the BMW being a hijacked vehicle.

"Fortunately, the owner was not harmed during the hijacking and was able to open a case at the Tsakane Police Station the same night," said Kgasago.

"The vehicle was found abandoned at 10am with minor damages.

"The owner was contacted and he brought along the vehicle's spare key for his recovered BMW to be driven to SAPS Van Ryn Deep Pound, once the forensics were completed."

Security guard won't let sleeping dogs lie

An ambulance was called to a local bar on Friday morning, last week, after a security guard was kicked by an unruly patron.

The incident took place at an establishment in Dalpark shortly before 2am.

The woman, who allegedly received medical attention following the altercation, came to the aid of the bar's supervisor, who was escorting two men from the premises.

The pair had been asked to leave because they had two small dogs with them and the bar does not permit animals.

As the group approached the exit, it is alleged the two men became aggressive and one of them started kicking the guard on her right upper leg.

A case of common assault was opened at the Brakpan Police Station.

Five cases of common assault and five cases of assault with the intent to cause grievous bodily harm were registered at the local station over the weekend.

Lone armed hijacker strikes in driveway

A Brenthurst resident was hijacked in the driveway of his Tweedy Street home on Thursday, last week – the same day the Brakpan SAPS Anti-Hijacking Task Team was disbanded.

According to information received from Brakpan police, the resident was confronted by a man armed with a gun at about 9.45am, as he was leaving his house.

The hijacker threatened the man with the weapon and made him lie on the ground. The resident was searched and robbed of R300 and his wristwatch.

The hijacker fled in the resident's vehicle, a white Kia Cerato.

A case of carjacking has been opened.

Cyclist critical after being hit by taxi

A 30-year-old man is in a critical condition after he was struck by a taxi while cycling along Van Dyk Street, in Brakpan, on Tuesday morning.

The exact detail to the cause of the accident, which took place at about 7.30am, will remain a subject for police investigation and comment.

"When Netcare 911 paramedics arrived on the scene, we found the man to be in a critical condition," said Athlenda Mathe, media liaison officer for Netcare 911.

"After stabilising him, paramedics transported the man by ambulance to a nearby hospital for further medical care."



Cachalia appalled by 'Plastic City'

The Democratic Alliance believes the Waste Department of Ekurhuleni is guilty of gross mismanagement and incompetence, which has resulted in failed refuse removal services, a filthy environment and shocking human conditions at the "Plastic City" squatter camp in Brakpan.

The litany of problems are selfinflicted, according to the DA's mayor-elect, Ghaleb Cachalia, who visited Plastic City, opposite the Weltevreden Landfill Site, on Tuesday, last week.

He was briefed by the party's spokesperson on waste, Clr Gary Scallan.

Scallan pointed out that, for the third consecutive quarter, no environmental audit has been conducted at any of the five landfill sites throughout Ekurhuleni.

In terms of Section 11.4 of the

National Minimum Requirements for Waste Disposal by Landfill, including Weltevreden, audits should occur at three-month intervals for large sites such as those found in Ekurhuleni.

"Simply put, the waste department forgot to renew the tender for the auditors," said

"This is in direct contravention of its own resolution that all tenders be advertised and filled three months prior to the expiry of existing contracts."

Scallan also stated the following as failed resolutions by the Waste Department:

- the conclusion of the rolling out of the 240l wheelie bins by the end of June 2016,
- the supply of blue plastic bags to all households to encourage recycling, and
- the development of an

e-waste plan for the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality.

Scallan stated that the municipality has a record of barely enforcing any by-laws whatsoever, so it comes as no surprise that the Solid Waste By-Laws, clause 21.4, which specifically states "No person shall enter a landfill site or refuse transfer station or mini disposal site with the purpose of scavenging", is being completely

Cachalia is appalled that thousands of people living in Plastic City and suburban Brakpan have to endure and breathe the poisonous gasses emitted by the illegal burning of plastic and e-waste inside the squatter camp.

The DA reportedly warned that the people who had set up shacks would soon number thousands and prove difficult

to move. This has come to pass, yet the governing party refuses to confront the problem by identifying suitable land, providing basic services and moving the Plastic City community.

"Even harder to grasp, is the governing party's utter contempt for the environment, even while it celebrates Africa Day with gusto and boasts about Ekurhuleni being a thriving aerotropolis that attracts investors," said Cachalia.

Scallan has submitted petitions to each sphere of government (Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality, Gauteng Province and Parliament) to request an investigation of the legality of waste activities within the Weltevreden Landfill Site, which is in contravention of Sections 16 and 26 of the Waste Management

Roadside robbery

A family was robbed at gunpoint along Heidelberg Road, near Withok Estates, on Saturday night, last week, after they were stranded on the side of the road.

A man, who was travelling with his wife and child, was forced to pull over near Koot Street, at about 7.35pm because of a problem with his

According to information received from Brakpan police, the man contacted his mother for assistance, and the woman, who was accompanied by her three daughters, arrived soon afterwards.

The man's mother and sisters were trying to help him with the car, when a purple Ford Fiesta suddenly pulled over.

Three men, all of whom were armed with guns, alighted the car and demanded the family's belongings.

The robbers made off with three cellphones, two bank cards and two sets of car keys.

Hijackers at large

A gang of four suspected hijackers are at large after shooting their way to freedom.

A shoot-out between the men and two employees from a car tracking company took place between 11pm and midnight on Thursday, last week, in Brakpan North.

Information received from Brakpan police indicates that the tracking personnel were following the men, who were travelling in a hijacked silver Volkswagen Polo.

The vehicle was spotted at the corner of Huntingdon Avenue and Craven Street.

After realising they were being followed, the men abandoned the car along Jansen Street, opening fire on their pursuers as they fled into the nearby veld.

The tracking personnel returned fire and their vehicle was damaged during the exchange of gunfire.

Police and EMPD members arrived on the scene, and a helicopter was dispatched to search for the men.

Despite all efforts, the men evaded capture. A computer tower was found in the hijacked Polo and was seized by police.

The Polo was also seized and taken to the SAPS Van Ryn Deep Pound in Benoni.

Three housebreakers sentenced to jail

The following cases were recently finalised in the Brakpan Regional Court:

• Angus Geyser (35) was sentenced to six years imprisonment for housebreaking and theft.

The break-in occurred at a residence along Hamilton Avenue, on December 4, 2012.

Two DVD players to the value of approximately R1 000 were

Fingerprints lifted by the Local Criminal Record Centre at the premises identified Geyser. He was arrested on April 14,

this year. Two years of the sentence on condition that he is not convicted of housebreaking with the intent to steal, theft, or any other attempts thereof, during the period of suspension.

 Albert Mandkawe (27) was sentenced to six years imprisonment for housebreaking and theft.

Mandkawe was identified by his fingerprints, which were lifted from a residence in Naboom Street, in Dalpark Extension Six, following a break-in on March 7, 2012.

About R20 000 worth of electrical appliances were stolen.

At the time of the sentencing, Mandkawe, a Mozambican national, was already serving an eight-year jail term for housebreaking and theft.

years of the sentence run concurrently with the sentence he is currently serving.

It was further recommended

that when Mandkawe is due for release, his legality in South Africa be investigated and deportation considered.

 Fernando Mabuwa (36) was sentenced to six years imprisonment for housebreaking and theft, and four years for theft.

He was convicted on two separate cases and, at the time of sentencing, was already serving a 10-year prison term for housebreaking and theft.

The housebreaking took place between 10pm on October 15 and 6.30am on October 16,

A residence along Rangeview Road, in Dalpark Extensio Six, was burgled of household appliances, a television set and a DVD player, to the value of about R15 000.

The following year, between 5pm on March 24 and 7.10am on March 25, a vehicle parked at a residence along Camelthorn Street, in Dalpark Extension Six, was broken into.

Two amplifiers, a radio and the vehicle's four wheels were

Mabuwa, a Mozambican national, was linked to both crimes by his fingerprints.

The court ordered that three years of the imprisonment run concurrently with the sentence he is currently serving.

It was also recommended that his legality in South Africa be investigated when he is due to considered.



•Het jy ander belangstellings?


Ek skilder, speel graag gholf en hou van kamp. Dit is vir my lekker om wandelroetes saam met my gesin te stap.






His hat-trick means that he is now the Peregrine League's top-scorer, with 18 tries.

T'S not often that two competitor products enter the local market within a week of one another.

Then again, the past two weeks have been an exception. Recently we've seen two plug-in hybrid SUVs enter South Africa; first, the Volvo XC90 T8 and now the BMW X5 xDrive40e, which I had a go in this past week.

→ IT'S A HYBRID

The X5 hybrid is very much like the other hybrid vehicles that we've seen on sale in the local market for years. It makes use of a small turbocharged petrol engine, supplemented by an electric motor. Both the electric powertrain and petrol engine can be used independently or in combination, depending on the driving conditions and of course, how much battery life remains.

→ GOING GREEN

The 2.0-litre turbocharged motor produces 180kW/350Nm, while the electric motor provides 55kW/250Nm. Combined, the vehicle - according to BMW - produces 230kW/450Nm, which

I can believe, having driven the vehicle with both powertrains active. The acceleration and performance on offer is impressive when both units are working in tandem with the eight-speed automatic gearbox. It will get from 0-100km/h in 6.8 seconds, which should keep the budding X5 driver happy.

→ BENEFITS

It's claimed that the new model consumes 3.4-3.3 litres/100 kilometres and a combined electricity consumption of 15.4-15.3 kWh/100km while being exempt from ${\rm CO_2}$ emissions tax. The consumption is impressive. The test route saw journalists drive a total of around 300km throughout the day and by the time we were done, the X5 still had three quarters of a tank of fuel left.

→ THE MODES

In terms of the hybrid drive system, there are several options the user can engage. The "MAX eDrive" means the car will run on electric power only, for up to 31km when fully charged. You can also activate the "SAVE Battery" which engages the petrol motor only and allows the electric motor to be charged while you drive. Then there's

"AUTO eDrive" which makes use of both motors to provide as much combined output as possible.

→ HOW DO I CHARGE THE THING?

The battery pack is housed under the luggage compartment of the car and uses a lithium-ion unit. It can be recharged by connecting to any standard domestic power socket or a BMW iWallbox, or the limited number of BMW charging stations around the country. I must warn potential owners that the iWallbox - which allows for a three-or-so hour charge - will set you back R25 000 while using a standard wall socket, will take up to twelve hours.

→ PRACTICALITY REMAINS?

The loading space has been somewhat compromised; the standard X5 boasts between 650 to 1 870 litres of luggage space while the hybrid model provides between 500 to 1 720 litres of luggage space.

The rest of the interior remains as one would expect from an X5, plus materials, ample space for occupants and very little in the way of Eco regalia. There are a few hints here and there that this is the hybrid X5 yet still remains pretty much a standard X5 inside, which isn't a bad

thing.

→ WHAT'S IT LIKE TO DRIVE?

Driving the hybrid is like any other X5 really, despite the fact that it doesn't make quite the same noise. If anything, it reminded me of how good a product the X5 is. There's an elephant in the room though. The Volvo XC90 T8, which I drove last week, has got a few trump cards in response to the X5. The first is the fact that the cost is similar but does offer a bit more. For example, the Volvo can seat seven, whereas the BMW seats five. The Volvo is also faster than the BMW and doesn't sacrifice any of its loading space to accommodate the battery pack.

→ **VERDICT**

It is admirable what BMW has done with the X5 eDrive hybrid model, then again, if you have your heart set on an X5, for around R200 000 less, you could have the xDrive25d, which will have a bigger boot and provide similar real-world consumption.

→ **PRICING** (standard model) BMW X5 xDrive40e:

The empire strikes back, with a Honda

WE ARE living in a time where many performance hatchbacks strike fear into some sports cars. We have four-wheel-drive pit bulls roaming our streets looking for a brawl. Think of the Volkswagen Golf R, Audi RS3, the Mercedes-AMG A45 and the imminent Ford Focus RS, just to name a few. These hyper hatches have been designed to attack a track and to put a smile on your face. Honda has long been a silent whisper and the wait was well worth it. Finally, the latest Type R is here and I got behind the wheel.

 $The \, Honda \, faces \, stiff \, competition \, in \, the \, segment$ with many of the customers driving off in the Golf R and A45 AMG. The Honda is not all-wheel, yet it does offer something else, which is pure driving thrill; something the keen driving enthusiast will appreciate. If it's quarter-mile times you're after then look away, if it's one of the best handling performance cars for around R600 000 that you're after then this Honda is it!



Let me elaborate on this by starting with the looks of the car. It looks purposeful, thanks to an array of wings, spoilers and flared wheel-arches. I'm pretty sure the clay model was sculptured with a katana instead of the usual tools. There is function to this form and that is aerodynamics. Everything on the car serves the purpose of keeping it glued to the road. It looks great, menacing even. At the rear there are large quad tailpipes protruding from the lower bumper however it's the rear wing that attracts most of the attention. If I had to fault the overall look I'd say the wheels tend to look small and this is because the wheel-arches are so big. Honda should have put some spacers in, just to give the car a wider stance.

On the inside, the car is finished in red and black. There's a touch screen, which controls all the multimedia functions. This, along with the climate control system, is angled towards the driver. The steering wheel is small, fat and feels good when gripped. However, it's the bucket seats that inspired me the most. I've had the privilege - many times - to sit in the driver's seat of a race car and the Type R comes closest to that feeling. The gear lever is short with a rounded silver ball on top; it's also a short throw stick so changes are lightning fast. There are seats at the back and this time you don't have to be a gymnast to get into them as the Type R is now a four-door. Some things that made me raise an evebrow are the materials (not the best of quality compared to those found in other cars) and the infotainment system is a laugh. The buttons are so small and after a week I still didn't know how to change the radio station, but that's not the point of this car so I'll stop complaining and tell you what it's like to drive. Powering the Honda is a new 2.0-litre V-Tec turbo engine, which develops around 228kW and 400Nm of torque. Power is sent to the front wheels via a six-speed manual gearbox and 100km/h is reached is 5.7 seconds.

Honda has also made use of a helical limited slip differential. This type of differential aids strong cornering traction, even during hard cornering. The technology, when compared to a traditional differential, reduces the Type R's lap time by five seconds per lap around the Nürburgring Nordschleife. It achieved a time of seven minutes, 51:42 seconds, which is impressive for a hatchback. Stopping power comes courtesy of powerful Brembo brakes. Push the +R mode button and a number of visual changes occur. The floating dial surrounds in the instrument binnacle change from glowing white to glowing red. A +R logo is displayed to the left of the rev indicator and the idling Stop system is disabled. With +R mode selected, several dynamic changes are activated within the Civic Type R's powertrain and dynamics systems. Engine responsiveness is heightened, with torque-mapping changed to a more aggressive and performance-focused setting allowing more

of the available torque to be unleashed at lower engine speeds. Forget any burps, grunts and bangs from the exhaust - all you hear is that turbo, whistling and dumping. Okay, one last complaint before I end this, in +R mode the ride quality becomes incredibly harsh, hard and uncomfortable. Drive over a coin and you can just about tell whether it's an R5 or R2. The problem with this is, when driving on our poor quality roads, the car tends to bounce from undulation to undulation. It takes a lot of work keeping it sorted but you know what... that's the beauty of this car.

It's not perfect when compared to the Germans: it's not the fastest or most powerful, but as far as driving goes, this car, at R600 900 (base price) ticks all the right boxes.

It's a hardcore driving machine, a tool and it's about time we got something like this, something that focuses on the task of being a performance car and not a combination of three different things at once.




