Driver wrecks neighbour's wall

A West Acres family could only look on in amazement as yet another car came crashing through their garden wall early on Saturday evening - for the fourth time in total and the third during the past three years.

The crash took place on the corner of Banket and Delta streets, bordering the access road to a town-house cluster.

In what appears to be an amazing feat, a relative of one of the neighbours managed to lodge her vehicle into the wall, at a right angle to the road.

Although the wall was destroyed, the attached palisade fence remained intact, and the driver could count her lucky stars that she came away unscathed.

The occupants of both the house and a granny flat on the premises where startled by a high-impact bang after 19:00.

They ran out to view the surreal sight of the car perched halfway into their garden. It was the first time a crash had occurred at that particular spot, as the three previous incidents were all at the other end of the yard at the bottom of a slope.

"The first time was years ago and simply a case of a not-too-secure handbrake failing.

"The two subsequent occasions involved neighbours and friends of neighbours - and a fair amount of alcohol," resident Ms Ciska Kay remarked.

"Sober people seem to have no problem

negotiating the wall," she added dryly. The driver retreated into the neighbour's house soon after the accident and refused treatment from rescue personnel.

The family doesn't have a solution to the problem, but is concerned about the regularity of the accidents.

"It's scary. The cars usually come crashing through the bottom of the garden right next to our bedroom wall.

"This time it's the area where my daughter usually plays. But what can you do?

"Wishing people would stop drinking and driving is like praying for world peace - it simply isn't going to happen, is it?" Kay concluded.

Unidentified gardener dies after collision with bakkie

A male cyclist in his thirties who worked as a gardener in West Acres, was run over and killed by a bakkie on Monday. Medical personnel rushed to the scene behind I’langa Mall near the junction of Flamboyant and Bitterbessie/Silver Oak streets at

around 09:00. They found that the man had already died from his injuries. His identity is being withheld since his family has not been notified of his death as yet. The woman who drove the bakkie was too shocked shortly after the incident to tell authorities exactly what had happened. The security camera on that specific strip of the road also did

not cover the spot where the accident occurred. The first paramedics on the scene, Netcare 911, declared the cyclist dead just after 09:00. It is suspected that he died from severe head injuries.

Daar is egter intussen besluit dat die borgaansoek vir eers oorgehou sal word en die aangeleentheid is tot 8 Oktober uitgestel. Bemiddeling sal intussen deur die hof oorweeg word.

Suspect misses court over second arrest

A second arrest prevented a resident from appearing for a court appearance last week. The man was due to appear on a robbery charge in the Nelspruit Magistrate’s Court on Thursday. However, he failed to attend because he was arrested on another charge by the Hawks the day before. Capt Paul Ramaloka, spokesman for the Hawks, has confirmed that the

suspect was apprehended last Wednesday afternoon, and that he was currently being detained in eMalahleni. *Nelspruit Post* has received confirmation from a member of the Middelburg Community Policing Forum that he was arrested in connection with the robbery of an SBV cash centre in eMalahleni that took place in April. The robbery case in Mbombela against the accused has been postponed to October 13.

Die saak is tot 29 Oktober vir die finalisering van die besonderhede hierin uitgestel. Die derde beskuldigde hou glo spesifiek

van Parmalat. Teen druktyd was dit onbekend wat met hom in die hof gebeur het. ‘n Opgeskorte vonnis van tot en met ‘n jaar en ‘n half kan diegene wat skuldig bevind word, in die gesig staar.

Loads of electronic goods only lead to emptying your pockets

A new scam that uses electronics and the newest technology as its selling point has been doing the rounds over the past week. The suppliers of these electronic goods send out chain messages detailing a variety of bargains in return for a cash deposit. One local resident, who wanted to remain anonymous, told *Nelspruit Post* about one of the incidents that made him realise the nature of the scam. “I received an SMS last Sunday from a man who claimed to work

at a local electronics store. He informed me about fantastic deals for a wide variety of electronics. The prices were very low and I enquired. The next week I constantly received nagging messages telling me to buy the stock before it was sold out.” Some of these low prices included a Samsung flat-screen television for R4 000 as well as a brand-new Playstation 4 for R1 500, which is valued at R6 000. After dealing with missed calls from the

apparent salesman for a week, the resident decided to meet with the supplier of these goods at I’langa Mall. After a few instructions the “salesman” eventually asked that the resident perform a “white coat” or R500 deposit into the supplier’s bank account before the electronics can be viewed. There was no trace of him. “It is important to make people aware. I know of some people who fall for this practice as getting the latest electronics seem very appealing,” the resident said.

Know all the legalities concerning domestics

Minimum wages are a much-speculated topic and are subject to yearly revision. Your relationship with your domestic worker has various legal requirements.

The employment contract is regulated by the Labour Relations Act of 1995.

However, due to its technical nature, many employers have not taken note of the content.

Non-compliance may result in the employer having to pay a fine of R5 000 or five years' imprisonment. *Nelspruit Post* has summarised the practical application thereof.

All domestic workers must be paid for every hour's work that they have performed.

The minimum wage is calculated according to where the employee works and how many hours they work per week.

The prescribed rate for a domestic worker who works more than 27 hours per week is R9,63 with a minimum weekly rate of R433,35 and R1 877,70 per month.

Domestic workers that work less than 27 hours per week may receive R11,27 in hourly remuneration, R304,29 per week and a monthly minimum of R1 318,48.

Where an employee is remunerated in excess of this amount, increases may be granted at the discretion of the employer.

The Labour Relations Act dictates that domestic workers may not work more than 45 hours per week, distributed in portions of a maximum of nine hours per day where the employee works five days per week and eight hours a day where the employee works more than five days per week.

Overtime becomes payable as soon as the employee works longer hours than 45 hours per week, at a rate of 1.5 times the employee's normal hourly remuneration.

The employee's wages may be paid in cash in an sealed envelope, by cheque, EFT or direct deposit.

Be sure to provide the employee with a

detailed payslip reflecting the employer's name and address, the employee's name, occupation, the rate at which the employee is paid as well as the amount of hours where the employee is paid per hour.

If overtime payment is made, indicate the amount of overtime hours' work that has been done as well as the rate at which the employee was remunerated.

Where deductions are made, they should reflect on the payslip as well.

Deductions include medical insurance, savings, pension fund, trade union subscription, rental and loan repayments.

Take note that loans to employees may only be granted where the monthly instalments will not cause more than 10% of their monthly wage to be deducted.

Furthermore, it is not permissible that

breakages be deducted from a domestic worker's remuneration.

Meals that are provided to the employee during working hours are not to be deducted from the employee's

wages. Rental may only be deducted from the employee's wages where the rental does not amount to more than 10% of the employee's total wage.

The unit in terms of which rental is paid must be waterproof, have a minimum of one door and one window and be in a good condition.

Domestic workers have also been under the protection of the Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF) since April 1, 2003. This means that employers must deduct one per cent from the employee's monthly income (before deductions) and also pay one per cent to the UIF.

These payments may be made monthly or annually, in advance. UIF legislation dictates that domestic workers who work more than 24 hours per month qualify for unemployment insurance.

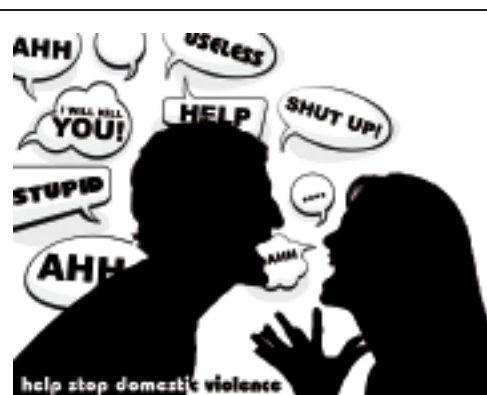

Blood-bank levels are critically low

The blood bank encourages all regular donors and those who have made a conscious decision to join the cause of saving lives, not to miss out on their next donation date.

According to the South African National Blood Service (SANBS) it currently has only a two-day stock of blood available.

Should a doctor request four units of blood, SANBS might be able to offer only two

It needs to maintain a level of five days at all times.

"Traditionally September is a difficult time for donors owing to preliminary exams and preparation for the final quarter of the year. As a result blood drives at schools and universities are generally not possible at this time and in conjunction with poor turnouts at companies' and organisational blood drives, stock levels are under immense pressure," explains Vanessa Raju, communications manager of SANBS.

"It is only with the help of selfless blood donors that we are able to turn this situation. We have implemented a cut-back approach when we are not able to meet the requests of doctors.

"This means that should a doctor request four units of blood, SANBS might be able to offer only two units, and this approach will continue until the blood stocks recover."

Remember, if you donated blood on Mandela Day, you are due to donate again. If you are aged 16 to 65, weigh more than 50kg, are in good health and lead a sexually safe lifestyle, visit a donation station this week. 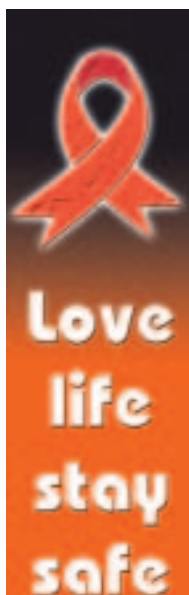
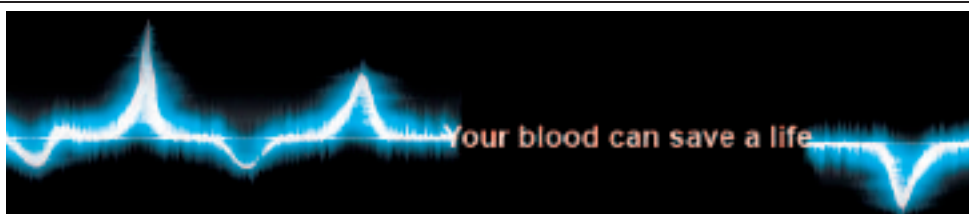

Afgri's roots firmly anchored in the Lowveld

The gold rush of the 1880s brought an influx of diggers to the Lowveld, which created a captive market for farm produce.

In 1886 WT Exall, a Barberton farmer, obtained a small quantity of tobacco seed from a passenger on a ship in the Durban harbour. Back on his farm in the Barberton district, he sowed it and was pleasantly surprised at the luxuriant growth of the plants and the large, green leaves which he obtained.

Dark air-cured tobacco was introduced at the annual Barberton Agricultural Show in 1886 and production rapidly increased after that. Barberton Snuff became the most popular in South Africa until World War II.

Growers sold their tobacco to a number

of buyers who abused the lack of unity to keep prices down. A grower meeting was arranged in 1926 by SN Spear and was attended by some 150 farmers to discuss marketing problems.

A resolution was tabled to form a cooperative, which developed into the establishment of Barberton District Cooperative Tobacco Co in 1927, with ETE Andrews as the first elected chairman of the nine-member board of directors.

The co-op developed into a multipurpose company and changed its name on July 30, 1965 to Lowveld Tobacco Cooperative (LTK) under the chairmanship of AJ (Braam) Raubenheimer, and extended its business to include cotton, beans, and

a general trading division. Raubenheimer who became a cabinet minister (water and forestry) in 1980 and was an honorary citizen of Mbombela, recently died.

After a merger between several other cooperatives in the Lowveld region, LTK's name changed again in 1985 to form Lowveld Cooperative or better known as Laeveld Koöperasie (LKB).

Lowveld Cooperative expanded and incorporated several smaller niche co-ops to become the biggest agro-business in the region.

Grower members voted unanimously to convert the co-op to a public limited company in 1997, which culminated in the establishment of Lowveld Corporate

Investments as a holding company, which included the tobacco activity.

In September 1999 the tobacco farmers decided to break away from this unit to establish their own independent company, namely Lowveld Golden Leaf Ltd which focused and specialised in the production, processing and marketing of flue-cured tobacco. This company later became SA Golden Leaf Ltd.

Afgri Nelspruit leased the shop in Bester Street from SA Golden Leaf. The lease period ended in December 2013 and a decision was made to move to a new premises. 5 Wild Berry Street in Riverside Extension 22 was chosen and the big move then took place.

Macadamia nut - worth its weight in gold

Macadamia nuts are quickly becoming an important crop in South Africa and are possibly the fastest-growing tree-crop industry in the country.

South Africa is the third largest macadamia producer in the world, after Australia (where they originated) and Hawaii. Macadamia trees take five to 12 years to produce nuts and a good tree can produce them for 40 years. The trees require a hot subtropical climate without much humidity.

Macadamias are now widely used in the confectionery, baking, ice cream and snack-food industries. Macadamia oil's rich, cushiony-skin feel and high-oxidative stability make it especially suitable for heavy creams and sun-care formulations. Medical research has shown that the consumption of macadamias may significantly lower the risk of heart disease.

Employment

Although most of the workforce in the industry is employed seasonally for harvesting and processing from February to August, it is estimated that at least 3 000 new job opportunities have been created on macadamia farms over the last decade and another 1 000 jobs in cracking facilities. In peak season, the industry currently provides employment for more than 4 500 farm workers and about 1 500 factory workers.

Since production is expected to double within the next five to seven years, employment creation will continue to grow at a similar pace.

Production areas

In South Africa, macadamias are mainly grown in three provinces: Limpopo (Tzaneen and Levubu), Mpumalanga (Barberton, Mbombela and Hazyview), and on the north and south coast of KwaZulu-Natal.

Market structure

The prices of macadamias are determined by market forces of demand and supply. The industry is export based with more than 95 per cent of annual production shipped to international markets. The United States of America, Europe and Asia are currently the largest markets for macadamias originating from South Africa.

Processing

The kernel is the main product from the macadamia tree. After harvesting, the husks covering the nuts are removed.

The nuts are fried, the shells are cracked, and the kernels are removed to be oil-roasted or dry-roasted. Kernels are commonly sold as snack nuts and chocolate-covered candy. Ice-cream manufacturers and the baking industry also use macadamia kernels as an ingredient.

The shell and husk also have uses. Shells can be used as mulch, fuel for processing macadamias, planting medium for anthurium culture, plastic manufacture and as a substitute for sand in the sand-blasting process.

Husks are used as mulch or composted for

fertiliser.

Oil can be extracted from culled nuts. The cosmetic industry, especially in Japan, uses the oil in soaps, sunscreens and shampoos.

The remaining press cake might be used for animal feed.

Drying

Freshly harvested, dehusked nuts contain 25 per cent moisture and must be dried before they are stored in bulk.

Wire frames containing three layers are used for drying. Air must circulate freely between the frames to prevent mould. A fan may be used. They can also be sun-dried, but if the freshly harvested nuts are exposed to the sun immediately, the shells may crack.

These cracks provide access

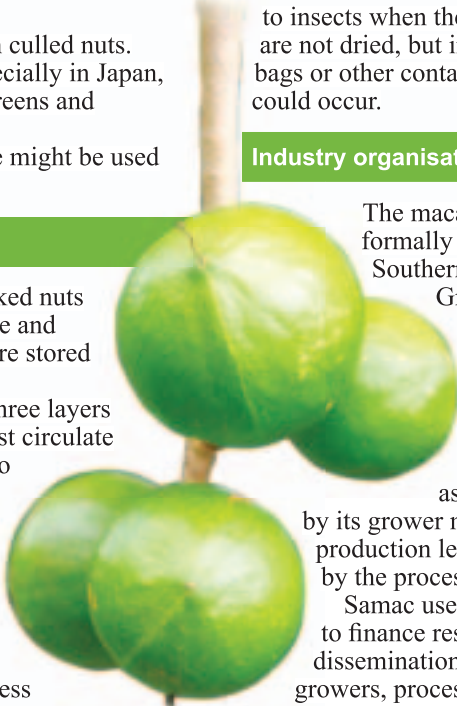
to insects when they are stored. If they are not dried, but immediately stored in bags or other containers, fungal growth could occur.

Industry organisation

The macadamia industry is formally organised through the Southern African Macadamia Growers' Association (Samac).

The association is comprised of macadamia growers, processors and marketers. The association is funded by its grower members who pay a production levy which is collected by the processors.

Samac uses the funds collected to finance research and the dissemination of research results to growers, processors and marketers.
