Trane rol oor dogter se dood

Trane het stil oor die wange gerol van familielede by die roudiens vir 'n sesjarige dogter wat verlede week tydens 'n speletjie raakgery is.

Die diens vir Avani Shiloh Jacobs is Dinsdagoggend by die United Pentecostal-kerk in Eerstelyst gehou.

Shiloh, die enigste kind van Danielle Jacobs, is onthou as "n energieke bondeltjie vreugde" wat diep in die harte van haar familie ingeklim het.

"Sy was vol lewe en het altyd iets gehad om te sê," vertel Shiloh se ouma, Agatha Jacobs.

Shiloh is verlede week Woensdag in haar arms dood voor hul huis, na die swaar wiele van 'n Jeep bo-oor haar klein lyfie gery het.

"Dis nog baie seer... Een minuut het sy nog verby my gehardloop en die volgende oomblik is weg," het Jacobs emosioneel vertel. "Sy sal baie gemis word...vreeslik baie."

Die gebeure van die voorval waar Shiloh haar lewensverloof het is met hartseer herleef.

"Die klomp kinders, seker altesama nege, het almal hier buite die huis gespeel," vertel Jacobs se man Kenneth. Oupa Kenneth sê hy het buite gestaan en met 'n vriend gesels voor die voorval.

"Die bestuurder in die Jeep het om die hoek gekom en die man was so besig op sy selfoon dat hy nie die kinders in die straat sien speel het nie."

Die kinders het glo 'n speletjie gespeel waar een van hulle doodstil moet sit of lê totdat een van die ander kinders aan hom of haar raak.

"Toe die Jeep aankom het die kinders uit die pad gehardloop, maar Shiloh het te laat opgespring en is toe omgestamp," het hy die gebeur herroep.

Jacobs, wat in die kombuis gestaan het tydens die voorval, het gehoor hoe die ander kinders haar roep.

Sy het haar na die bebloede lyfie van haar kleinkind gehas. 'n Inwoner en dokter van

die omgewing het op die toneel afgekom en die familie te hulp gesnel.

"Hy het Shiloh se pols gevoel en gesê sy leef nog, maar dat dit nie goed lyk nie."

Die dokter het sy selfoon aan die naaste omstander gegee om die ambulans te bel terwyl hy die sesjarige ondersoek het.

"Daar was net soveel bloed, ons kon nie sien waar dit alles vandaan kom nie," vertel Jacobs. "Dis toe die dokter haar kop ooplig

dat hy die wond sien."

Jacobs meen dat een van die Jeep se wiele oor haar kleinkind se kop is.

"Die dokter het 'n handdoek uit sy kar gekry en om haar kop gebind om die bloeding te keer."

Jacobs het gehelp om die handdoek teen haar kleinkind se kop te hou.

Terwyl die familie vir 'n ambulans wag, nadat hulle 'n noodnommer twee keer moes

skakel, het die bloed uit die sesjarige se mond en neus gestroom.

"Ek kon sien sy het seer... sy het gesukkel om asem te haal," sê Jacobs.

Shiloh het na 'n ruk stil geraak. Sy het haar laaste asem uitgeblaas in haar ouma se arms. "Die bestuurder het rou betoon na hy Shiloh gestamp het, ons kan hom nie blaam nie, want dit was net 'n ongeluk," het Oupa Kenneth gesê.

Lyk in spruit gevind

Die lyk van 'n jong vrou is Vrydag in 'n spruit in Nantes, Eersterust gevind. "Ons vermoed die vrou was tussen 20 tot 25 jaar oud en die polisie stel ondersoek in," sê Sinoville se polisiewoordvoerder, Mirna von Benecke. Geskokte inwoners en omstanders het op die toneel saamgedrom waar die polisie die lyk uit die vlak spruit verwilder het. Daar word vermoed dat die vrou se lyk deur iemand in die spruit gegooi is. Nog 'n gissing is dat sy voor haar dood verkrug is. Von Benecke sê geen bewyse hieroor is tot dusver gevry nie. "Slegs 'n geegteke doodsonderzoek sal kan vasstel wat gebeur het," sê von Benecke.

Another young suicide

A young man has hanged himself with an electric cord in Eersterust.

Tshepo Lucky Mashego (25) was found last Tuesday by his uncle, Hilman Cave, who lives with the family.

"I was sitting in the living room when I decided to go and wake Lucky up to do some work for me," he said.

"When I got to his room, I knocked twice. I didn't receive any response. The door was stuck and I went outside to check through the window what was going on. That was when I saw the cable Lucky had used to hang himself."

A shocked Cave tried to break down the door and struggled to get it open. He called his wife and they alerted the police.

Mashego was unemployed and was known as a reserved individual. He only completed grade 10.

Cave said the family was distraught, no one knew why Mashego took his own life.

"My heart is very, very sore."

"He could have told us what the problem was and perhaps we could have tried to stop him from doing this. We don't know why he did this."

Mashego was scheduled to be buried on Sunday (13 September).

Stamp out bullying

After another video of violence on school grounds surfaced on social media, the Gauteng education department said such conduct should be stamped out.

"The department is aware of the matter and views it in a very serious light," said education spokesperson Phumla Sekhonyane. "Investigations are currently underway to determine appropriate action. The department would like to reiterate that bullying has no place in our schools and whenever it rears its ugly head, it is dealt with immediately."

The video sent to *Rekord* on Monday shows Derdepoort Primary School pupils fighting. It was apparently taken by another pupil. Two girls appeared to be arguing, before the scene escalated into violence. Classmates appeared to be egging on the confrontation while others recorded it on their cellphones.

Sekhonyane said the department would dispatch officials to the school to investigate. She said the department was running a staff development programme for teachers to help them deal with problems such as bullying and drug abuse.

"The department conducts advocacy and awareness programmes. In 2011, we rolled a pledge in Hammanskraal, for pupils that they remain drug-free throughout their schooling career," Sekhonyane said.

"We also participate and support the national Ke Moja campaigns that raise awareness on drug abuse, violence and

bullying among pupils in and around schools communities."

Last week, reports of school bullying also surfaced in the north of Pretoria after parents posted what they claimed to be proof of bullying on social media.

A parent of a pupil posted a picture of a bruise on the side of her son's face, saying he had been beaten up and bullied by other pupils. Mad

Rage against Child Abuse, a non-profit organisation, organised a meeting at the school last Friday to discuss bullying.

"The meeting was between the parents, chairperson of the governing body, the lawyer for the school and the principal," said Sekhonyane. "The principal explained the disciplinary action taken thus far against the pupils involved and the parents were satisfied with the school's action."

The truth about bullying

Three types of bullying:

Physical bullying:

Physical bullying includes hitting, kicking, threatening or pushing someone and also stealing, hiding, or destroying a person's belongings. Harassment is more common and also forcing someone do things he or she doesn't want to do.

Verbal bullying:

Verbal bullying includes name-calling, teasing, taunting, insulting or otherwise verbally abusing someone.

Relationship bullying:

Relationship bullying is common with children, it includes refusing to talk to someone, excluding someone from groups or activities, spreading lies or rumors about someone and also hazing, harassment and humiliation.

Tips for bullying victims

Reach out to someone, tell a parent or teacher

Stay calm and confident in the moment

Ignore the bully

Try not to fight back - it can make the bullying worse

Do not show the bully that you are sad or mad

Practise what to say to a bully next time with your friends, parents or teachers

Tell your friends about it, there is safety in numbers



ANCYL marches in a protest over services

The DA expressed disappointment at the conduct of ANC youth league members during a protest march in Lindo Park (Ward 84) last Wednesday.

Party chief whip for Tshwane, Councillor Marietha Aucamp called the protest a cheap political stunt.

"They [the league] wanted to create an illusion of relevance. They could have addressed their issues in a much more civil manner as had been offered by DA councilor for ward 84, Roelof Fourie," she said.

Addressing the failures and shortfalls of municipal governance will not be fixed by destructive actions.

Aucamp said the DA was only informed of the protest on 30 August when the group wanted to know if Fourie would be available to receive a memorandum.

She said Fourie told the group's frontman, Puseletso Nkatane, it was unnecessary to organise a march to communicate with him as he was more than willing to meet with any group regarding whatever issue or matter they wanted to raise.

"It is regrettable that his offer was not accepted."

"We remain of the opinion that it is much more productive and effective to have amicable civil conversations regarding issues than to start off on an aggressive note like a

protest march," Aucamp said.

Aucamp said neither Fourie nor her party had received the memorandum, in which the league demanded jobs, services and information sharing. Therefore she could not respond to it.

She emphasised that Fourie and the DA

were committed to engage directly in a civil manner with any aggrieved person.

"Addressing the failures and shortfalls of municipal governance will not be fixed by destructive actions, but by constructive engagement," she said.

In Fourie's absence the memorandum

was handed to ANC councillor for Ward 84, Selejane Moses Phasha.

He promised a speedy and effective resolution to the grievances. He also commended protesters on their peaceful march, without the customary accompanying damage to property.

Rotarians for Family Health & Aids Prevention (RFHA) is the convener and managing partner of the program.

A project on this scale cannot happen without commitment and sacrifice from many individuals. "It is through the dedication and hard work of all partners but particularly the volunteer aspect of many Rotarians on the ground that has made this campaign such a huge success," says Sue Paget, Southern Africa Programme Director of Rotary Family Health Days.

The effects of the campaign will be felt long after the last volunteers go home. In bringing together so many South Africans from all walks of life to work as one, Rotary Family Health Days contributes to building a legacy of social cohesion that will ultimately improve the quality of life for everyone. "It's hard work," says DG 9400 David Grant, "But it is absolutely worth it." The Rotary Theme for 2015 is: *Be a gift to the world*. The Rotary Family Health Days have brought this to life in the most meaningful way possible.

'n Stryd van tussen ses en nege maande lê vir 'n vrou wat in die onlangse chaos by Mahem-reンbaan, wes van Pretoria beseer is.

Karlien Purves (45) is in 'n kettingbotsing tussen twee voertuie vasegen en met 'n gebreekte pelvis en heup hospital toe gehas.

Purves vertel hierdie week dat dit tussen ses en nege maande sal duur vir haar om te herstel.

"Die vier skroewe in haar pelvis en heupbeen bly dan nog daar tot en met die dag van my dood," sê Purves.

Purves is een van ses mense wat beseer is in die chaos by die renbaan toe drie in-dringers moles gemaak het.

Die voertuig waarin hulle voet in die wind probeer slaan het, het in die toeskouergebie buite beheer geraak.

Purves sê: "Ons was die aand, na die verrigtinge, op pad terug na die bakkie en het vir die kinders gestaan en wag toe dit gebeur."

Purves onthou goed hoe sy en haar seun se vriendin, Amelia Wilke, langs die voertuig gestaan het voor die kettingbotsing.

"Ek het 'n groot geraas 'n paar motors verder gehoor. Toe sien ek 'n voertuig

aangejaag kom, sonder ligte en met sy deur nog wawyd oop," vertel sy.

"Hy moes seker nog mense in die pad gestamp het en die volgende oomblik stamp hy die kar wat voor ons parkeer het."

Die bestuurder van die silwer Toyota Yaris het glo beheer verloor oor sy voertuig wat toe die kettingbotsing veroorsaak het. Verskeie voertuie is beskadig.

'n Toyota Camry langs die bakkie is getref wat Purves en haar vriendin vasegen het. Purves se man Stuart sê duike is in die metaal sigbaar waar hulle getref is.

"Met die impak, met my vrou en Amelias tussen-in, het die bakkie nog boonop teen 'n kar langsaan ook gebots."

Na twee weke herstel Wilkes goed van haar berisings. "Die spiere in my been was geskeur en daar was inwendige bloeding," vertel sy.

Purves het nog baie pyn na haar vyf-uur lange operasie dieselfde aand.

Sy het die hulp nodig om op te staan en beweeg stadiig met die gebruik van twee krukke.

Die Hercules-polisiekantoor ondersoek klages van eiendom-beskadiging, aanranding asook roekeloze en nalatige bestuur.



Faith never passive

SA Red Bull X-Fighters Moto-cross favourite Thomas Pagés emerged as the winner of the 405th stop of the tour to beat Clinton Moore in a tough competition at the Union Buildings on Saturday.

It is a Wednesday morning, it is a grey world – the world of government officials.

"Where is room D29?" The front desk lady, wearing a perm, nudges me to the left.

Long passages. No colour. Only grey. Grey people watching the clock. Grey files and forms.

Ahh! Room D29. I knock on the door. Two secretaries stuffed tightly together in a small office. Files neatly labelled – Media Events and Media Briefings – cluttered their desks. It is the municipal office in Lyttleton, Centurion.

Inside room D29, another door leading to a separate office – the boss' office. Blessing Yassir Manale is the mouth, mayor Kgosiensonto Ramokgopa's spokesperson and director of communications.

Golden words drip from the 41-year old's mouth, most carefully crafted to spin his principal and the city to peachy light.

He sits behind his polished wooden desk dressed in formal suit, moustache neatly trimmed. Some people refer to him as the city's Clark Gable.

"Coffee?" Blessing asks. "Champagne, please," I reply. His moustache twitches as he smiles: "Sorry, this is not Nkandla. Fortunately we have Nescafé." I accept.

The phone rings. "It is for you, Mr Manale," the secretary, as petite and refined as an African Barbie, says as she peeps into the office: "a journalist from Mail & Guardian is on the line." He waves his hand... "Tell him I will phone back, please," he says.

Will you, Mr. Manale? I wonder to myself... Blessing is well-known for his jovial personality and cunning, but not for keeping to deadlines. Sometimes he doesn't return calls, yet others he will just ignore the endless list of questions from journalists.

Blessing, could you please come back to me as soon as possible? Blessing, what is going on with the water pipes in Waterkloof? Blessing, why did...? Blessing, Blessing, Blessing...

A never-ending stream of emails to his computer, never-ending phone calls from journalist asking questions that he does not have answers to... not easy to be a mayoral spokesperson for the third biggest metropolis in the world...

"I sometimes do not reply to questions as I do not want to lie to the media. The mayor is a difficult, difficult man. I want to be his advisor, but he is doing his own thing."

"He [the mayor] is a hard worker, but he is not a cut and paste person. And when he is angry, all hell breaks loose."

Yes, it is not an easy job to be the mayoral spokesperson...

"I want to be his eyes and ears. I need to supply the media his speech – but he keeps on changing his speeches," he says.

And then there's the endless flak from the citizens as well. Some despise the mayor. And there is also the daily pomposity of DA members to deal with.

And as if he does not have enough on

his already full plate, he made – sometime last year – the famous foot in the mouth blunder that kept his face red for weeks...

An email inadvertently sent out in which he promises to fob off a journalist and attack the civil rights organisation AfriForum. He had received a set of questions from a journalist to which he commented: "Please send me any general report. I will spin and spew at AfriForum in one paragraph."

But instead of forwarding to colleagues, it appears AfriForum became the recipient. Blunder!

And then there was the Bronwyn Engelbrecht-saga. The mayor had been rude to her at a council meeting. Engelbrecht flipped. The DA flipped and Blessing had to put out the fires.

"I did not know what to tell the media... it was the mayor's personal opinion."

The media still awaits his "spin and spew" on that one too.

He is just human, after all.

Blessing was born into a Muslim family in Limpopo, a stone's throw from the University of Limpopo. As the little nine-year-old, he would look at the university thinking: "I want to be a doctor one day – but a doctor without a medical degree." Maths was not one of his strongest subjects, but this boytjie was clever – he skipped a grade – and he could spin stories from left to right so he decided to study law.

He obtained his LLB-degree and then high-profile jobs followed: special advisor to Vice-Chancellor of the University of Western Cape, deputy director of communications, director for international cooperation, chief director of environmental planning and cooperation.

But the bug bit so he later chose to stay with communications.

Though Blessing is a loyal member of the ANC, he is tired of Nkandla, tired of the Gupta-scandals and tired of corruption that's bringing the country to its knees.

He loves Afrikaners – he can speak, read and write Afrikaans fluently. After all, he stays in Elardus Park, a very Afrikaans neighbourhood in the east of Pretoria.

Blessing believes the ANC will win the municipal election next year.

"Where is the DA going to get votes from?" he asks

"I love Pretoria. It is the first bastion of the democratic country."

Did he just use that dreaded word, Pretoria?

"Pretoria is youthful and vibrant and the city should be inclusive," he says, switching to golden words. "Pretoria is the best city in South Africa and people must realise this is the capital city – not Johannesburg or Cape Town."

In the evenings, when he is done chasising annoying journalists and advising the mayor, he goes home to his wife and three children.

Already a holder of a master's degree, maybe that "doctor without a medical degree" is still possible.

"Well, have a blessed day, Blessing," I say as I walk out.





Property ownership hinges on your savings

Statistics from the SA Savings Institute show the average household debt to disposable income ratio last year, is around 78.3%.

This means a majority of consumers are unable to put money aside for savings because of indebtedness.

Adrian Goslett, regional director and CEO of RE/MAX Southern Africa, says compared to other emerging markets, South Africa is considered to have a low savings rate.

"The result of a low savings culture among consumers is few have the cash reserves to make large purchases and will therefore be forced to rely on financial institutions to loan them the money."

"This once again pushes up their debt-to-income ratio and will mean they are viewed by lenders as less creditworthy."

"A consumer with high debt is classified by lenders as higher risk and therefore, will be charged a higher interest rate on their bond, if it is approved at all."

Those who do not currently have savings but would like to purchase a property in the future, will need to make some financial adjustments to start putting money aside.

"With electricity tariffs and the general cost of living rising, it is becoming increasingly difficult for potential buyers to prepare for purchasing a property which will include lowering their debt and saving for additional costs not covered by the lender. This highlights the extreme importance of personal financial planning."

Since the introduction of the National Credit Act in 2007, affordability has been a key focus for potential buyers.



While it was commonplace for buyers to secure home loan finances without some form of a deposit pre-2007, in today's market most buyers will need to show they have saved a portion of the home's purchase price saved up in cash.

Ideally buyers should have about 10% to 30% of the purchase price saved up, along with the other costs associated with a property purchase such as transfer duty and attorney fees.

During 2007, the bond approval rate was around 70%, however this dropped to ap-

proximately 28% the following year.

Over the last seven years, consumers have grown more accustomed to bond approval requirements.

Bond origination group, BetterLife Home Loans, says only 29% of home loan applications submitted to lenders in the first quarter of this year, were declined outright.

This is an improvement from the 32% a year ago, and 38% during the first quarter of 2013.

"It must be noted, however, while there has been an improvement in bond approval

statistics, it does not mean banks have eased up on lending requirements."

Lending criteria remains stringent with banks placing a high emphasis on a buyer's affordability.

When assessing a bond application, the overall picture of the client's credit history is taken into account, including aspects such as the total amount of credit outstanding as well as the applicant's ability to pay off debt.

There are several ways in which consumers can show higher levels of affordability:

- Seek the expertise of a professional financial adviser and planner, who can assist with a personal finance plan,

- Create a budget which includes savings and stick to it,

- Avoid buying luxury or unnecessary items,

- Shop around, comparing prices to find the best value,

- Stay away from credit, rather pay cash whenever possible,

- Review all policies and medical aids annually to ensure you are getting the best possible deal,

- Go green to save on electricity and water costs.

"Those who are able to cut down on their spending and reduce their household debt-to-income levels will be in a far better position to show the required affordability level to purchase a home."

Although it requires discipline and may be difficult at first, consumers will need to initiate a finance plan that works for them to keep their homeownership dreams alive," Goslett says.

Beware of buying the wrong house

You can return most things you buy if you discover it does not fit or does not work. But if you buy the wrong home, chances are that you will be stuck with it for several years – or have to pay quite a price to correct your mistake.

However, says Richard Gray, CEO of Harcourts Real Estate, there are some tried-and-tested preventatives for what is known in the real estate industry as "buyer's remorse" and it is worth running through these before you go house-hunting.

"A recent study in the UK revealed about one new buyer in 10 regrets their choice to some degree, with the most common cause of their dissatisfaction being the feeling they could perhaps have got a better deal if they had taken more time to choose."



Heinrich du Preez het op 'n piepklein houtplatform aan die buitekant van 'n warmlugballon gestaan toe hy op 'n hoogte van 1 000 voet gholfballe met sy ses-yster na die Pecanwoodgholfbaan onder hom geslaan het.

Du Preez is bekend as 'n avonturier wat in die verlede al baie waaghalsige en opwindende dinge gedoen het om sy meer as 30 gholf-verwante wêreld-rekords op te stel.

Verskeie van hierdie rekords word amptelik deur die *Guinness book of records* erken.

Sy jongste avontuur was egter 'n waagstuk wat vergelyk kan word met dinge wat professionele waaghalse sou doen.

In samewerking met Conrad van

Wyk en sy span van Life Ballooning in Hartbeespoort, het Du Preez 'n platform van hout ontwerp wat aan die buitekant van een van dié maatskappy se warmlugballon-mandjies vasgeheg is.

Die platform was net groot genoeg vir Du Preez om daarop te staan, terwyl 'n klein strokie kunsgras voorop geplak is waarby hy die gholfballe kon plaas om dit vanuit die lugruim te slaan.

Du Preez is met 'n harness aan die lugballon se mandjie vasgemaak, terwyl hy op die platform gaan staan het voordat dit sou opstryg.

Ses mediaverteenvoudigers was in die lugballon-mandjie om die skouspel te dokumenteer, waaronder 'n joernalis van *Rekord*, asook 'n lid van Du Preez se ondersteuningspersoneel, sy vrou Megan, en die vlieënier, Van Wyk.

Van Wyk het die lugballon tot op 'n hoogte van 1 000 voet laat styg, vanwaar Du Preez verskeie balle met sy ses-yster geslaan het om sodoende die eerste persoon ter wêreld te word

wat dit kon regky.

Ná 'n vlug van sowat 30 minute bokant die Hartbeespoortdam-omgewing het Van Wyk die lugballon weer veilig op moeder aarde geland.

Intussen het die res van sy personeel gereed gestaan met vonkelwyn om die prestasie te vier.

Soos al Du Preez se rekordpoggings, was hierdie waaghalsige toertjie weer nie net ter wille van homself nie.

Met hierdie avontuur is sy veldtog, 'Golfing for Teddy', van stapel gesku.

Verskeie bekende persoonlikhede sal in hierdie veldtog met Du Preez saamwerk, terwyl hy voor Desember vanjaar in al nege die provinsies 'n ronde gholf gaan speel om geld in te samel vir die projek.

Aan die einde van die projek sal honderde spesiale 'pratende' teddiebekte aangeskaf word.

Dis speelgoed sal dan tydens die Kersseisoen aan kinders en ander hospitaalpasiënte regoor die land uitgedeel word.

In 2005 was Johan van Heerden vir die rugby-overhede in Pretoria maar net nog 'n matriekseun.

Hy is nie eens goed genoeg geag om na die Cravenweek-proewe genooi te word nie.

Hy was in 'n skool waar sy kansie byna nul sou wees om ooit deur een van die 'keners' raakgesien te word.

Die afgelope naweek het Johan saam met die nasionale span van Roemenië op 'n vliegtuig geklim, onderweg na die rugby-wêreldbekertoernooi (RWB).

Hy het 'n week gelede Tonga in sy eerste toets vir dié land gespeel en word tans beskou as die beste slot in Roemenië.

Dié land is tans 17e op die Internasionale Rugbyraad se ranglys en word beskou as die sewende beste rugbynland in Europa.

Van Heerden se rugbyloopbaan-storie is die soort materiaal wat Hollywood-skrywers inspireer, maar dit is ook 'n les aan elke rugbyspeler wat weens verskeie redes in die Suid-Afrikaanse opset nooit 'n regverdigde kans gekry het nie.

Van Heerden se verhaal gee hoop aan elkeen wat bereid is om in homself te glo, op te offer en hard te werk om sy doelwitte te bereik.

Dié reus van 1.96 meter, wat 115kg weeg, moes as matriekseun tevreden wees om by die AVS se Bokkieweek uit te draf, aangesien hy as leerling van Hoërskool Hercules nooit regtig 'n kans gehad het om deur die Bloubul-skolekeurders raakgesien te word nie.

Tukkies-rugbyakademie betrokke was, het hom egter gesien speel en reëlings getref dat hy die volgende jaar by dié akademie aansluit.

Vanuit die Tukkies rugbyakademie het

Van Heerden die geleenthed gekry om aan die Pumas se 0.21 proewe deel te neem, wat hy met albei hande aangegry het.

Hy het twee jaar vir die Pumas se juniors uitgedraf en in die tweede jaar as 20-jarige ook 'n paar wedstryde vir hul Curriebekerspan onder die aflagting van Jimmy Stonehouse gespeel.

In 2008 het Stonehouse hom 'n senior kontrak aangebied, maar na een seisoen het 'n ernstige besering sy loopbaan bedreig.

Nadat hy byna 'n hele seisoen op die kantlyn deurgebring het, is Van Heerden vir die Griffons (Welkom) geleen, waar hy uiteindelik twee frustrerende seisoene deurgebring het.

Van Heerden het egter groter gedroom en hy het sy rugby-CV aan 'n agent gestuur in die hoop om iewers in Europa 'n kans te kry.


Al wat die agent beskikbaar gehad het, was 'n kans om vir die Baia Mare-klub in die noorde van Roemenië te gaan speel.

Dit is een van die twee groot klubs in hierdie Oos-Europese land, wat eers onlangs aan professionele wedstryde begin deelneem het.

Hy het die kans aangegryp en 'n kontrak met Baia Mare geteken. Kort voor lank is hy ook gekies vir die Buchrest Wolves, 'n streekspan wat deelneem aan die European Challenge Cup, waar hy teen topklubs uit Engeland, Frankryk, Skotland, Ierland, Wallis en Italië gespeel het.

In dié liga het Van Heerden die afgelope drie jaar nie net gerefereel teen Springbokke gespeel nie, maar hy kon ook so eie vermoë toets teen sommige van die wêreld se beste spelers.

Hy het só goed van homself rekenskap gegee in Roemenië se plaaslike rugby, asook in die European Challenge Cup, dat die nasionale rugbyoverhede onmiddellik voelers begin uitsteek het om hom langer in die land

Ná die afgelope naweek se nederlaag van 28-36 teen die Goue Leeus is daar heelwat Bloubul-ondersteuners wat skielik weer in sak en as sit oor die vertoning van hul span.

Hy het gepraat oor akkuuratheid en fokus wat nie op standaard was nie.

Marais was egter nie mismoedig nie. Hy het gesê dat hierdie nederlaag waarskynlik 'n tydige waarskuwing is dat probleemgebiede in die span se mondering nou reggestel moet word.

Hy het dit baie duidelik gemaak dat die vaste skrums besig is om 'n krisis vir die spanbestuur te word en daarom kan drastiese stappe in sy spankeuses in dié afdeling verwag word.

Ten spyte van Marais se duidelike teleurstelling, was daar tog ook 'n mate van selfvertroue by hom te bespeur. Op die keper beskou kan dit ook verstaan word.

telinge om vanjaar die Curriebeker te wen, skul daar waarskynlik potensiaal in die Blou Bulle van 2015 wat 'n nuwe goue era op Loftus Versfeld kan inluï.

In perspektief gesien het die Leeus ná Saterdag se wedstryd waarskynlik meer om of bekommert te wees as die Bulle.

Al moet 'n mens erken dat hulle met enorme intensiteit gespeel het in daardie eerste 35 minute, sal selfs die grootste ondersteuner van Johan Ackermann se span moet erken dat hulle ook 'n mate van geluk aan hul kant gehad het.

Gehalte spelers soos Marcel van der Merwe en Dries Swanepoel sal waarskynlik nie elke Saterdag die amateuragtige foute maak soos dié wat tot Franco Mostert en Ruan Combrinck se drieë gelei het nie.

Dan sal enige kenner ook kan getuig dat Marius van der Westhuizen se hantering van die wedstryd soms baie vreemd was.
