

# Residential war continues

The Tshwane metro's woes regarding illegal squatters on open spaces of land of the metro are set to continue, according to law experts.

Lawyers for Human Rights' (LHR) Louise du Plessis said in a recent media statement that unless the metro urgently allocated land to migrants to the city, the problem of illegal occupation would continue to escalate this year.

Du Plessis assisted various communities that had been evicted from land they occupied last year, only to see them return to it some time later.

She said that because of the influx of people into the city, and the shortage and high cost of formal housing, people could not be accommodated in formal areas and started to put up informal structures on open land instead.

According to news reports, Judge Neil Tuchten remarked that courts ought to be careful in evicting the homeless if they did not have somewhere else for them to go.

The metro maintains it is providing housing in the form of RDP houses, but the

waiting lists are long and many have been waiting for years for a home of their own.

“Until city officials realise that people who migrate to the city need land where they can settle informally, this problem will not go away,” Du Plessis warned, anticipating that the courts would again be called on to intervene.

“The metro may say ‘evict these people’, but the Constitutional Court has made it clear that these people must receive help,” she said. Pretoria east resident, Johan Muller, told *Rekord* that he was determined to have the issue of illegal squatters properly addressed. “I have been fighting the issue of squatters on the border of my property for the past two years. Money is being spent on street name changes while the poor continue to live in squalor. In the east, I pay some of the highest rates and taxes to live next to a squatter camp. I will not stand for it.”

Marié Johnson, who lives in a private estate close to the Pretoria East cemetery, added to the sentiments of Muller.

“Next to my estate is a growing squatter camp and despite calls to the police and the ward councillor, very little is being done to control the influx and activities of the people

living there. The news that our problems with squatters will continue is not good.”

Pieter Smalman, who lives in Wingate Park, told *Rekord* that he had to spend large amounts of money on security upgrades while the squatters lived on an open property

along Solomon Mahlangu Drive.

“Since their removal at the end of last year, crime has noticeably gone down. Squatters are a very definite social and security problem, I hope we can make sure they do not make a return.”

# System stops corruption



A new system has been put in place by the Tshwane Licensing Department in an attempt to stop corruption and fraud during learner's licence tests, the Tshwane metro police recently said.

This is after a Licensing Department official in Pretoria was dismissed late last year for writing a learner's licence test on behalf of a candidate.

"Unlike the previous manual system, this new system is computerised and can only be accessed by the candidate writing the test, or managers that mark the test," said Tshwane metro police spokesperson, Senior Superintendent Isaac Mahamba.

Mahamba stated that candidates would receive a password for the computer system when booking their licence test and that this password could only be used by the candidate on the set test date.



The new learner's licence testing system may mean the end of fraud and corruption.

"An outsider cannot access the system, as it requests information such as personal details and passwords that are only known by the candidate. The only other person that can log in on behalf of a candidate is a Licensing Department official," he said. With the new system, police were able to arrest Maria Bambo, a Licensing Department official, after she wrote a learner's licence test on behalf of a candidate for a fixed fee.

"Bambo's manager noted an irregularity, as the candidate somehow completed the learner's licence test sooner than other candidates. The candidate was then confronted and confessed that Bambo wrote it on his behalf for a fee. Bambo, who faced charges of fraud and corruption, was released on bail shortly after her arrest in August. We then started with internal disciplinary actions and she was dismissed in November," Mahamba said.

# E-toll tariff inconsistency

The Department of Transport announced that it has noted the e-toll tariff error, where the *Government Gazette* in Afrikaans stated different e-toll tariff rates to the English version, and said it would be fixed.

"We wish to state that the mistake in question will not affect the validity of the legislation and that the Department of Transport and Sanral are currently correcting the mistake. A revised version will soon be published," the department said in a statement.

This came after the Justice Project South Africa announced that the e-tolling tariff published in the *Government Gazette* contained different e-toll charges in the English and Afrikaans versions. According to the English version, the Barbet e-toll gantry on the N1 charges alternative e-toll users R17,40, but the Afrikaans version states a fee of R5,80. "Both of the tariff notices were signed by the acting director general of the Department of Transport and there-

fore carried equal and conflicting weights. Sanral and the Department of Transport have been uncooperative towards our requests for clarity on the enforcement process, instead referring us to the regulations," said Justice Project SA chairperson, Howard Dembovsky.

Dembovsky said Sanral and the Department of Transport should cease the levying and collection of e-tolls until the matter was corrected. "Our attorneys addressed correspondence to the minister of transport, calling upon her to immediately repeal the offending Tariff Gazette," he said.

Meanwhile, the Department of Transport also slammed an SMS claiming that Sanral and the police are setting up illegal road-blocks and forcing people to buy e-tags as a hoax. Departmental spokesperson, Tryani Rikhotsa, said the message was fake.

"Sanral and the Department of Transport have no agreement with traffic authorities to either force people to register for e-tolling or to check whether or not they have an e-tag."

# New Year's fireworks a traumatising experience for pets

Many pet owners started the new year off scrambling about trying to find their lost dogs following the illegal use of fireworks in and around Pretoria. Traumatised dogs scratched through fences and broke windows trying to get away from the loud bangs surrounding them.

Debbie and Theo van Stryp from the Moot area tried giving their dogs calming medicine. "Our poor dogs were left in a state of panic. We gave them calming medicine, but it did not help much. On the first day of the new year, our animals had to suffer through the side effects of the medicine all because of people who waste their money on fireworks. It is ridiculous."

Joanne Esterhuyse said she spent several days trying to calm a house full of frantic animals. "I looked after a few people's pets over the festive season. One of the dogs broke through our palisade fence and a gate to try and get away from the noise. He was badly injured, as the fence cut through his skin. It sounded like World War III outside," Esterhuyse said.

Esterhuyse also said that the fireworks were extremely bad this Christmas Eve. "People shot crackers throughout the week.

I even heard fireworks going off on the Wednesday evening after New Year's Day. The skin on the dogs' noses was torn, as they tried to break through their kennels."

The Tshwane metro police executed the festive season's operations by focusing on businesses selling fireworks and the illegal use thereof.

Rick Allan, the Tshwane SPCA's managing director, said that the Tshwane SPCA received a complaint from the public regarding alleged illegal firework activity in Mountain View and Eersterust. "We reported this incident to the metro, who will investigate the matter. Animal safety, however, falls under our jurisdiction and we will investigate matters in terms of the Animal Protection Act if possible animal cruelty took place," Allan said.

On the SPCA's Facebook page many people posted cases of missing dogs, most of whom went missing on New Year's Eve or Wednesday. According to Korky Levanon from the Tshwane SPCA, they have received 120 reports since Thursday of stray animals that have been taken in by the community. "Luckily some of these pets had microchips and they were quickly taken back to their owners," Levanon said the SPCA took in 20 strays on Friday alone.

"There is usually a two-day delay before people lodge a complaint because they are either on holiday or they think the SPCA is closed," Allan said. "It is horrendous how many stray animals were found."

Levanon confirmed that by Tuesday, 15 pets had been safely returned to their owners.

Fireworks can cause many problems for animals as they can be traumatised, run away, or get themselves caught in small areas. "Animals are very sensitive towards sound. Dogs have seven times more acute hearing than humans and cats are even more sensitive," Allan said.

"The main factor is fear. The sound triggers a fight or flight response. Most animals get stuck in small areas when they try to get away from the noise, which can sometimes be a fatal situation," he said.

The Tshwane metro police started by-law operations to crack down on dealers selling fireworks illegally. According to these by-laws, any person who wants to sell fireworks from their business premises must have a licence from the SAPS Explosives Unit as well as a certificate of registration from the chief fire officer. No fireworks may be

sold in public places or from trailers, this includes street traders.

The metro police is also working closely with other law enforcement agencies to regulate the sale and use of fireworks. Businesses selling fireworks without a certificate of registration will receive a spot fine of R2 500 with an additional fine for any other fire safety violations found. Those who want to use fireworks for private or professional displays must apply at the offices of the chief fire officer for permission. This will ensure that fireworks are used in a safe manner and will not constitute a fire hazard.

Superintendent Isaac Mahamba, metro police spokesperson, said the metro police received numerous calls from the public about the illegal trade or use of fireworks, but no arrests were made. "The metro police

is still investigating these complaints. These complaints could not be attended to on New Year's Eve as most officers were deployed to Soshanguve, where a riot took place." By Monday the metro police still had not made any arrests in this regard, Mahamba said.

The Tshwane metro advises the public that all matters relating to dead animals lying in the street and open public places should be reported to the municipal Environmental Health Services one-stop centre on 012-358-4656. In the case of impounded animals that may have been classified as strays, the metro has appointed a service provider who can be contacted at 012-328-2893 to check whether the animal has been impounded. All matters relating to cruelty to animals remain the responsibility of the SPCA.

Derduisende matrikulante het Dinsdag gejubel en gejuig nadat die Minister van Onderwys, Angie Motshekga, die finale matiekresultate bekend gemaak het.

Die top 20 matrikulante landswyd, waarvan drie Pretorianers is, is ook tydens 'n ontbyt in Sandton bekendgemaak.

Siphesihle Sithole van Makhosini School in Soshanguve, Wini-Louise Myburgh van Afrikaans Hoër Meisieskool in Brooklyn en Thabang Manamela van die Prinshof Skool het as die top drie matriekleerlinge van Pretoria uitgesonder.

Myburgh het ook as landswyf top Wiskunde-leerling weggestap.

"Ek wens die Klas van 2013 geluk toe as die beste klas sedert die begin van demokrasie, en moedig elke leerling aan om verder as hul voorgangers te presteer en die beste van hoër onderwys, die werkspelk en in hul algemene bydraes tot die samelewings te maak," het Motshekga gesê. Sy het gesê nadat 562 122 voltydse matrikulante hul laaste eksamen geskryf het, die 78,2% slaagsyfer

met 4,3% in vergelyking met 2012 gestyg het.

"Toe die matrikulante van vandag, in 1995 gebore is, was die nasionale matriek-slaagsyfer 53,4% in vergelyking met vandag se verstommende syfer. Ons mikpunt vir 2014 was 75%, maar ons het ons teiken met 'n jaar oortref," het sy gesê.

Gauteng het 'n 87% slaagsyfer bereik in vergelyking met 2012 se 83,9%. Dus het Gauteng 'n 3,1% verbetering geniet.

'n Totaal van 85 122 Gauteng-matrieks het vanjaar geslaag. Teenoor verlede jaar, het 17,42% meer leerlinge met universiteitsvrystelling geslaag en kan dus by tertiêre opleidingsinstansies inskryf.

Pablo Mamonyane van Hoërskool Akasia het universiteitstoelating gekry en gaan hierdie jaar politiek by Tukkies studeer.

"Ek wil eendag 'n minister word. Maar intussen gaan ek eers vir 'n rukkiewerk voor my studies begin."

"Ek is dankbaar teenoor alle rolspelers wat dit moontlik gemaak het om die vrou se kennis op te spoor. Dit was inderdaad goeie Moot-spanwerk," het Mulder gesê.

Xander Loubser,woordvoerder van Best Care, het gesê dat drie kinders en hul ouers in 'n kop-aan-kop botsing in Paul Krugerstraat betrokke was.

## Eersterust police clamp down

A total of 76 people were arrested during a series of roadblocks and crime prevention operations by the Eersterust police this festive season. According to Constable Sam Shibambo, spokesperson for the Eersterust police, the aim of the operations was to create a safe and secure environment for all the residents of Eersterust.

More than 40 of those arrested were arrested for liquor-related offences. "The other half were arrested for road traffic offences as well as on drug-related charges," Shibambo said.

He added that all the suspects had already appeared in the Pretoria Magistrate's Court. In another, unrelated incident, a suspect was arrested for the possession of a

suspected hijacked vehicle.

The police also launched a surprise raid for all wanted suspects in the area during late December. A man in his late thirties wanted for armed robbery was traced to a house in Delphinium Street. Upon seeing the police, the man and his accomplice fled on foot. The police, however, managed to arrest him and in the process recovered the vehicle that he allegedly used during a robbery. "The preliminary investigation revealed that the vehicle was hijacked in Pretoria West during December 2013," Shibambo said. The suspect has already appeared in the Pretoria Magistrate's Court on charges of possession of suspected stolen property and armed robbery.

## Hospital exemplifies the festive spirit

Children at the Louis Botha Children's Home in Queenswood celebrated an extra jolly festive season thanks to a local hospital surprising them with a donation of gifts. The Louis Botha Children's Home has serviced the community since 1918 as a non-profit organisation that looks after the welfare of abused children.

These children are removed from their parents and placed in the care of the home by the Children's Court due to abandonment, neglect, emotional or physical abuse.

Their primary purpose is to provide the children with clothing, housing, schooling, food, security and stability. In addition, they aim to provide the children with the necessary

therapy, life skills and emotional support they need in order to become responsible adults and curb the cycle of abuse.

The home currently cares for 100 children between the ages of 7 and 18 years. The children are divided into groups of 12 and each group lives in separate houses under the supervision of house parents.

"The staff at Mediclinic Muelmed all contributed towards the gifts, which were donated during a special visit from representatives of the hospital to the home during December. Fedics, Muelmed's catering contractor, also contributed by spoiling the children with lunch during the visit," Trish Wolmarans, spokesperson for Muelmed said.

She said that the Christmas spirit was definitely in the air and that staff members

were truly touched by the children's excitement on the day.

"To see their faces lighting up was just an amazing experience and we were happy that we could make a difference in the lives of these less fortunate children during the holiday season."

To cover the running costs of the two children's homes, the marketing team has the giant task of raising R25 620 000 annually, which boils down to R218 per child per day. Only 38% of this amount is subsidised by the government. "By supporting the Louis Botha Children's Homes you will give back to the community by supporting an institution that is effectively administered and motivated to help children reach their full potential," Wolmarans said.



## Editorial comment

In these early days of 2014, one is almost filled with a feeling of déjà vu. Issues that concerned us at the start of 2013 are still with us and continue to fill our newspapers and our minds.

The festive season is usually the time when crowds flock to the malls and keep the tills jingling.

It is also the time of financial hangovers.

People spend far more than their budgets allow and January and February are usually bleak months when consumers have to start paying back on their credit cards and other newly acquired debts.

What makes the start of 2014 even worse is the petrol price that increased on 1 January and the spectre of the e-tolling system that started late last year.

Further to this is rising food prices and a weaker rand.

Fuel prices rose to an all-time high on New Year's Day.

The price of petrol was bumped up by 30c/l, but if the rand remains at the level it was last week that increase will look tame by comparison to the 95-octane price, which could break the R14/l barrier for the first time.

The petrol price could rise by as much as 50c/l next month and diesel by more than 30c/l, according to data from the Central Energy Fund for the first week of the year.

The rand fell last week to its lowest level against the dollar in nearly five years.

The currency was trading at about R10,65 to the dollar on Friday. And uncertainty about the impact of monetary policies in the

US still dampens the rand's prospects of appreciating in the coming months.

### Road Carnage:

Many families are entering the New Year with deep sadness after having lost a loved one in the road carnage that reached record highs this year.

This is in spite of the numerous warnings from road traffic authorities and others to drive carefully and not to drink and drive.

### Education:

January is also the time for the matric results, which will be the subject of endless debate throughout the month.

Thousands of successful candidates who last year wrote the grade 12 national certificate will face the bleak prospect of finding any type of meaningful employment.

Only about a quarter of the more than 700 000 pupils who wrote the exam qualified for degree studies at a university.

Only one in four of the pupils who earn a matric exemption will go on to finish their

degree within the minimum time. As in previous years, much emphasis has been placed on the national pass rate, as if this is the only criteria to judge the success of the SA school system.

Professor Jonathan Jansen wrote a column in a Sunday newspaper saying that the education authorities hope we are ignorant and that we will, like them, compartmentalise this data in isolation of the SA school system.

These authorities will not tell us that these pass rates are still calculated at a base of 30% in some subjects and 40% in others.

The reality is that if one removes the top 20% of schools from the national averages, a very dark picture emerges.

Yet in spite of these gloom and doom prospects, it is in human nature to push on and persevere, and we wish all our readers an exceptionally good and successful new year.







## Higher income needed

According to the latest statistics from BetterBond Home Loans, SA's biggest mortgage origination group, homebuyers in SA now need to earn a gross monthly income of around R30 000 to buy an average home costing some R952 000.

The BetterBond figures also show that 64% of buyers currently have to pay a deposit in order to secure a home loan, and that the average deposit required for a home priced at R952 000 is around R99 000 – or 10,4%.

"This puts the average home loan required to buy such a home at R853 000, and the average monthly bond repayment at just over R7 400," said BetterBond CEO Shaun Rademeyer. "Now in the days before the National Credit Act, when the simple rule of thumb was that your monthly bond repayment should not exceed 30% of your gross salary, that would have meant that a gross salary of R24 700 was enough. But in terms of the act, banks are obliged to try to stop consumers from becoming over-indebted. So when they consider a home loan application they must now also take into account your existing debt commitments and regular monthly expenses and see if there is enough disposable income left over to comfortably cover the monthly bond repayment."

"And because of the high household debt levels in this country, and the continually rising cost of food, transport, utilities, healthcare and education, most prospective homebuyers need to have higher earnings. This is in order to ensure that there will be a big enough amount 'free and clear' every month to cover their bond instalment."

Things are a little easier for first-time buyers, said Rademeyer, with the average home price in this sector of the market having risen by just R27 000 in the past 12 months and deposit requirements having shrunk considerably to between about 6% and 10%.

"What is more, about two-thirds of the 100% bonds that are being granted are going to buyers at the affordable end of the market, where most buyers tend to be first-timers."

In any case, he noted, the banks' still-strict lending criteria do not appear to have put much of a damper on the demand for home finance – or in fact on the banks' willingness to lend to qualifying applicants. The BetterBond statistics show a 3,75% year-on-year increase in November in the number of home loan applications received and, even more significant, a 14% increase year-on-year in the number of applications formally granted (that is, approved and taken up by the borrowers).

The figures also reveal a 10,5% year-on-year drop in November in BetterBond's initial decline rate. That is the percentage of applications declined by the first lending institution to which they are submitted. It also reveals a 15% year-on-year increase in the ratio of applications declined by one bank but approved by at least one other.

This took the group's average approval ratio to 76% in November, which means that it is securing a bond approval for at least three out of every four of its applicants. The statistics reveal that about 80% of these approvals are taken up by borrowers and converted to formal grants.

# Know your boundaries

With new housing development and the sale of stands in gated communities starting to pick up again, buyers must make sure they have accurate information regarding boundaries, beacons and stand numbers.

Berry Everitt, MD of the Chas Everitt International property group, said most property sale agreements contain a clause saying the buyer has familiarised himself with the location and extent of the land he is buying, but that very few buyers do in fact really 'walk the boundaries' before they sign.

"And while that may not be a problem when the stand they are buying is in an established suburb and visibly defined by the boundary walls or fences around other properties, it could turn into a major headache in a new estate or township." When such developments are launched, he said, the developers or their agents usually do

erect clear stand markers, but as time goes on, these may well be moved or lost as a result of construction work, which will leave the site plan as the only indication of where stands lie and their boundaries fall.

"At which stage it is often all too easy to mistake one piece of vacant land for the one next door, or to visualise a stand being bigger than it really is, or to write the wrong stand number on a sale agreement."

Writing in the *Property Signposts* newsletter, Everitt noted that no reputable estate agent would, however, try to sell land under such conditions, and that consumers who do not want to end up owning the wrong stand should not buy in such circumstances either.

"They should insist that the seller enables them to see clearly what they are buying – even if it means calling in a surveyor to erect new beacons."

## Kan Bulls wéér sukses behaal?

As gevolg van die Blou Bulle se swak vertoning in verlede jaar se Curriebekerreeks, beskou die meeste ondersteuners van die Bull 2013 as 'n mislukte seisoen.

Ondersteuners van die Blou Bulle en die Bulls is egter oor die afgelope dekade bederf met al dié sukses wat spanne op Loftus Versfeld behaal het en daarom vergeet hulle maklik dat die Bulls in 2013 tweede op die algehele puntelys gëeindig het en direk vir die halfeindstryd gekwalifiseer het.

## Bad start for Titans in Ram Slam T20 series

The Unlimited Titans are the joint champions of the Momentum One-day Series and the current defending champions in the Sunfoil Four-day Series.

They were also the champions in the Ram Slam T20 Challenge two seasons ago, but last season they surrendered the title to the Highveld Lions.

If the Unlimited Titans, therefore, want to become the first team to write their name on all three of the major trophies in the same season in these local series, they will have to start pulling up their socks. The Ram Slam T20 Challenge started the past weekend with a feast of T20 cricket at Newlands in Cape Town, where all six South African franchises were in action. It formed part of the cricket festival in the Cape, which was organised to make up for the Capetonians' loss after the Indian cricket tour was shortened, which resulted in them missing out on a test match.

The Titans were involved early on Sunday in the first game of the day, when they had the privilege to open the local T20 cricket season with their game against the Dolphins.

The Unlimited Titans captain, Henry Davids, won the toss and chose to field first. Initially it went very well with the Titans in

the field. Wickets fell with regularity and at the end of the eighth innings, the fourth batsman of the Dolphins was already back at the pavilion, while the men from Durban only had 37 runs on the scoreboard.

Unfortunately it was the end of the success of The Unlimited Titans' bowlers, because Vaughn van Jaarsveld (82 from 56 balls) and Kaya Zondo (41 from 33 balls) came together for a very useful and undefeated partnership of 117 runs from 72 balls. These two men maintained an average run rate of 9,75 per over and brought the Dolphins' total to 154 runs when their 20 overs ran out.

To bat at a rate of 7,75 runs per over for victory was, on the face of it, not asking too much from The Unlimited Titans. After all, they had men like Davids, Jacques Rudolph, Heino Kuhn, Farhaan Behardien, Faf du Plessis, Albie Morkel and David Wiese in their line-up.

Unfortunately, most of these stars eventually failed and it was only Du Plessis (24 off 21 balls), Behardien (19 of 20 balls) and Wiese (42 from 24 balls) who could feel satisfied with their contribution. Thanks to excellent bowling by men like Kyle Abbott, Craig Alexander and Daryn Smit, The Unlimited Titans were indeed limited to just



146 runs in their 20 overs while they lost seven wickets in the process.

The Unlimited Titans must, therefore, wake up very quickly if they dream of playing in the final of this tournament in about a month's time on 9 February. Their next game is this week (9 January) at SuperSport Park in Centurion. Meanwhile, the Titans are at the bottom of the standings in the four-day Sunfoil Series after the first four games were completed. The champion team

in this series is not determined at the end with a semi-final and a final. The team with the most league points after a double round robin will be the winner. The Titans have much hard work ahead in the six games to come if they want to defend the title successfully. This series will continue directly after the completion of the Ram Slam T20 Challenge in February and the last game will be played between the Titans and the Warriors between 3 and 6 April in Centurion.
