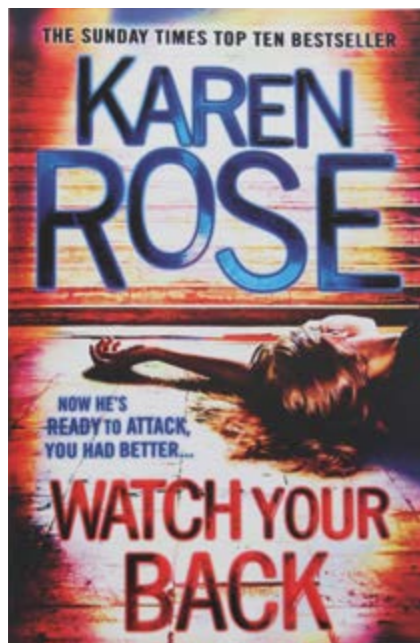

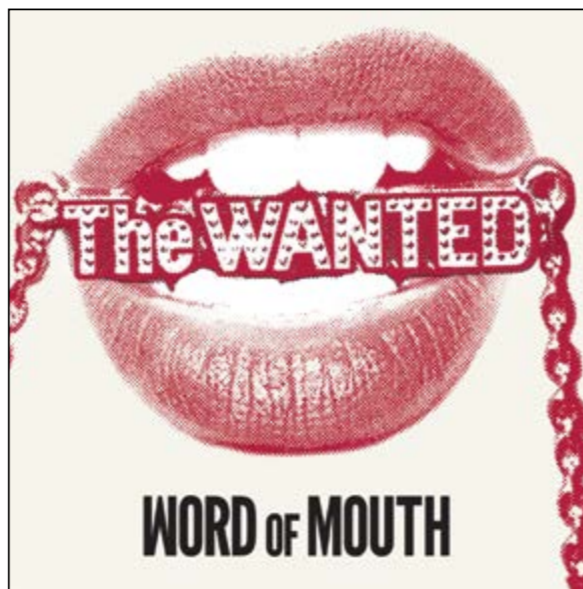

Valentine Cocktail

2 1/2 parts vodka
3 strawberries (cored)
1 celery leaf (size of a thumb)
Splash lime juice
Muddle, strain, serve up in a martini glass.

2 parts light rum
1/2 part triple sec
1 part lime juice
1/2 tsp sugar
1 cup ice
5-10 strawberries (to taste)
Combine all the ingredients in a blender. Blend well at high speed.
Pour into a collins or margarita glass.
Serve with a straw.

1 1/2 parts vodka
1/2 part raspberry liqueur
1/2 part syrup
5 rose petals
Champagne
Muddle rose petals and syrup in a cocktail glass and add ice. Pour vodka and raspberry liqueur and then fill with champagne.

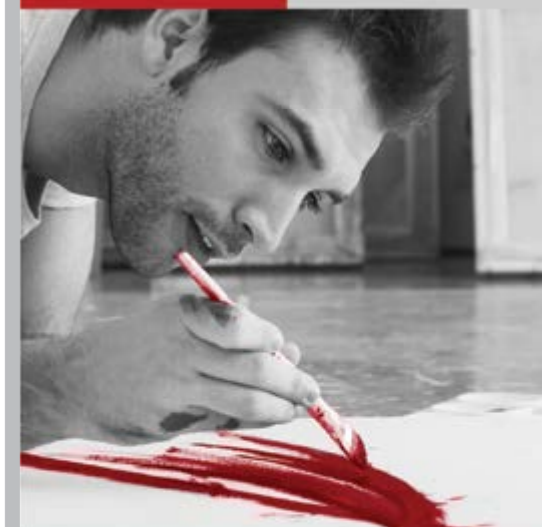

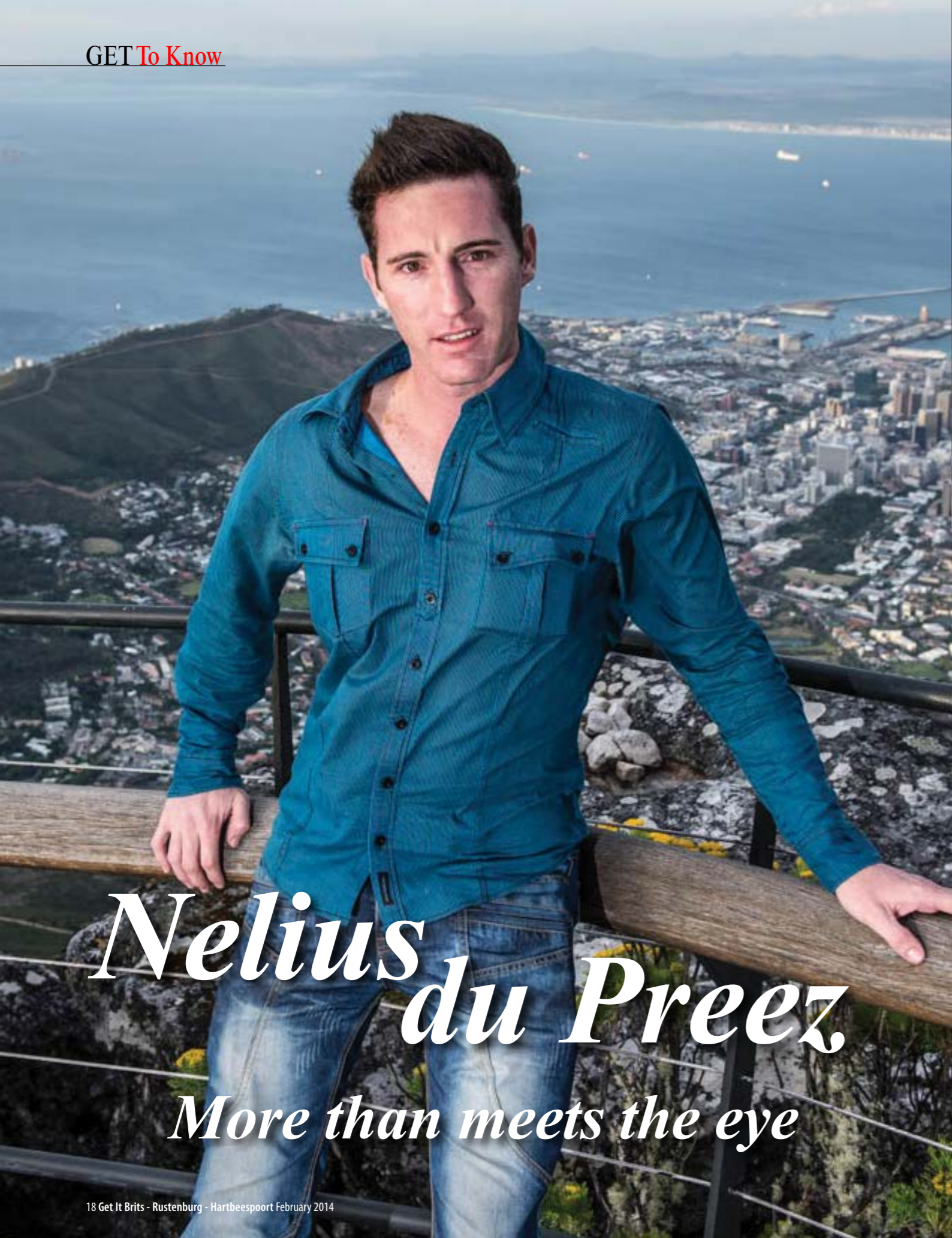

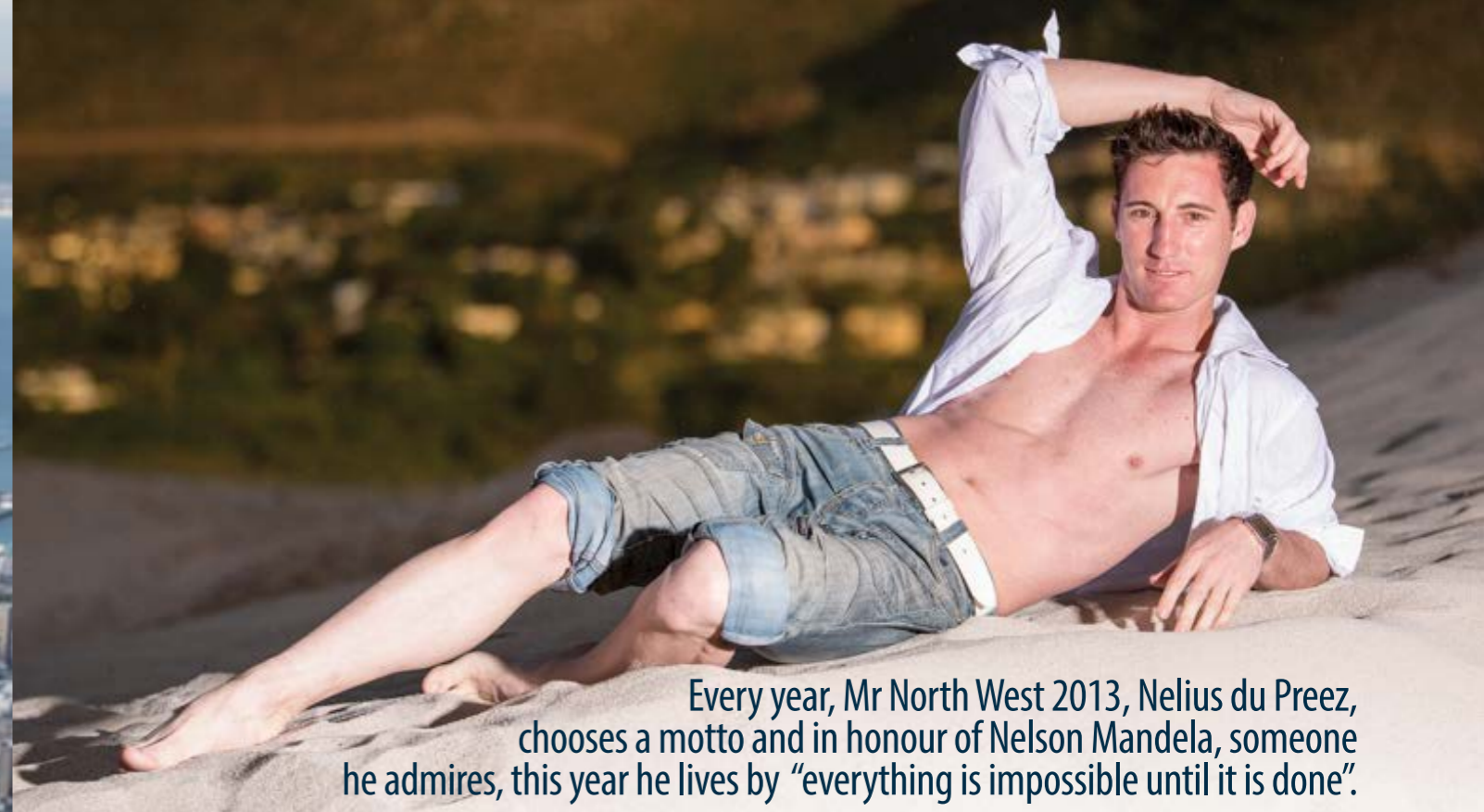

Nelius du Preez

More than meets the eye



Every year, Mr North West 2013, Nelius du Preez, chooses a motto and in honour of Nelson Mandela, someone he admires, this year he lives by "everything is impossible until it is done".

Nelius is a young man who has packed more into his 26 years on earth than many people do in a lifetime, and there is a lot more in store from this talented and dynamic entrepreneur.

Besides holding down a full-time position as a process operator in the demanding and brutal world of the platinum mining industry, Nelius runs a talent and casting agency for the film industry, teaches drama to school children, hosts charity shows, owns several beauty pageants, has contributed two short stories to a text book for the Department of Education, and plans to establish a creativity centre in Rustenburg, his hometown of the past seven years.

"I regard my title and participation in beauty pageants as a platform from which to make a difference in the world. I don't view these competitions as a means of hoarding sashes or being in the limelight," says the runner-up of the 2013 Mr Mzansi Africa competition that was held in Cape Town in December.

One of his earliest childhood memories is standing on a chair in the church kitchen so that he could reach the counter, mixing the jam and peanut butter for sandwiches distributed to the needy. He has continued this involvement with charity throughout his life. "Today's beauty pageants are run like businesses. Long gone are the days that it is just about good looks. Most have a

strong charity component and participants work very hard to raise funds for worthy charities," he says. During his reign as Mr North West he has supported the SPCA and CHOC, a charity to help children who suffer from cancer and their families.

An all-rounder, Nelius is just as at home in the business world as he is in the arts. Through his talent and casting agency, DuWoudt Productions, he has worked on the likes of films such as "Fanie Fourie's Lobola", "Strike Back" and "Long Walk to Freedom".

Born in the Free State, Nelius completed his schooling in Potchefstroom. He was involved in music, drama, modelling and design from a young age and

matriculated with distinctions in Singing and Music. After school, he completed a degree in Human Resources Management at Unisa, a qualification that has stood him in good stead in his business dealings and charity work.

Unlike many men involved in the modelling and beauty pageant arena, Nelius is not a metro male. As he regards his body as his tool of business, he eats a healthy diet and believes in regular exercise, but doesn't mind a braai with friends.

Coming from a big family, personal relationships are important to him and he has a solid friendship base with whom he regularly socialises. Although he believes in living

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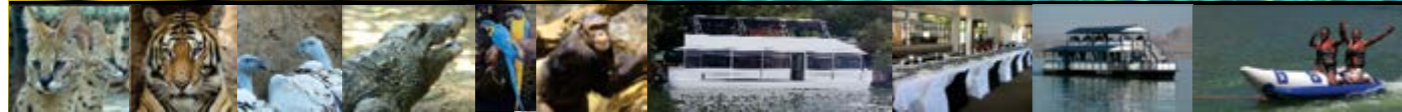
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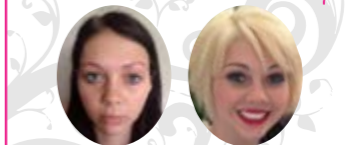
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MEET YOLANDE
